SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 348.4898 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MYERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 348 TO REGULATE AND PERMIT COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITIES

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b): a certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 348,4898 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

Ordinance No. 348 by replacing Artide XDA in its. entirety with "COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITIES." The purpose and intent of the ordinance amendment is to establish regulations and development standards to permit Commercial Cannabis Activities in the unincorporated areas of the County of Riverside per the Medicinal and Adult-Lise Cannabis, Regulation and Salety Act ("MAUCIRSA") by providing a means for regulating the cuthwition, possession, manufacture, distribution, processing, storing, labeling transportation, delivery or sale of medical and adult-use cannabis and medical and adult-use cannabis and medical and adult-use cannabis and in Ordinance No. 348, 4898. Under the ordinance amendment such commercial Cannabis Activities would be subject to discretionary approval of a conditional use permit and development agreement. The ordinance amendments for commercial Cannabis Activities, in addition to amendments to Article XIXh, Ordinance No. 348, 4898 also makes necessary edits to other affected sections within Ordinance No. 348, effect 60 days after its adoption.
