

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

California Elections Code §§ 10002, 10402, and 10403 allow jurisdictions to request that the Board of Supervisors approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct and consolidate elections by submitting a resolution requesting these services. The attached Exhibit A listed jurisdictions have requested the Registrar of Voters to conduct its election. The Registrar of Voters has the resources to provide these services. The County will not be reimbursed for the federal and state office elections but the Registrar of Voters will receive reimbursements from local jurisdictions for the full cost of conducting their election.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

Registered voters in the County of Riverside will have the opportunity to vote for several federal, state, and local offices which are all listed on the attached Exhibit A.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The County will receive reimbursements from the various local jurisdictions for the full cost of conducting their election. The County will not receive reimbursement for the cost of election of federal or state offices. In current budget, no budget adjustment needed.
