

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **Assistance League of Temecula Valley** - \$2,500 funding will be used to support the Operation School Bell program, which provides new, school appropriate clothing & shoes for students K-12 attending school districts within the First District.
2. **Kiwanis Club of Uptown Riverside** - \$1,500 funds will assist in helping needy families in Riverside Unified School District. Kiwanis adopts 200 needy RUSD families to feed during the Thanksgiving holiday season.
3. **United Way of Inland Valleys** - \$1,000 funding will be used to support the GEMS (Girls Excelling in Mathematics with Success) program in schools within the First District. The program targets seventh grade girls to help develop positive interactions with mathematics.
