BACKGROUND:

Summary

The California Land Surveyors Association Education Foundation (Foundation) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit public benefit corporation which provides scholarships aid to students, financial support to educational institutions, for the furtherance of educational purposes or to undertake educational studies with published reports.

The items donated were two electronic/optical total stations used for land surveying, building, and construction. Both units are approximately 16 years old and are considered antiquated technology. Both units were scheduled for surplus, and would have had very little resale value due to being so outdated. The equipment was provided to the Foundation on March 24, 2018. This ratification of the donation is necessary to formally remove the assets from the department's asset list.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Donation of these items provides support to a non-profit educational foundation, which has a benefit on the furtherance of education in the field of land surveying.

Additional Fiscal Information

There is no impact on the general fund. The items were fully depreciated and no longer needed or used by the department.
