#### **BACKGROUND:**

### **Summary**

The County of Riverside is a member of CSAC-EIA, which provides insurance coverage for counties and other public entities at pooled rates. The County currently participates in the following CSAC-EIA insurance programs: Property, Excess General Liability, Excess Medical Malpractice Liability Program, Excess Workers' Compensation and other programs such as Crime, Watercraft and Pollution.

Under the terms of the CSAC-EIA Memorandum of Understanding, it is required that each member's Board of Supervisors appoint its representatives.
