

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **Fox Riverside Theater Foundation - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the Students at Broadway Education and Outreach Program. This year's goal is to cover the cost of tickets for K-12 students in the First District.
2. **Big Brothers-Big Sister of the Inland Empire - \$1,500** funding will be used to provide support to a free after school program that matches high school students with elementary school students on school campuses in the 1<sup>st</sup> District to promote academic and social support.
3. **Martin Luther King High School, "King High Remembers" - \$1,500** funding will be used to provide assistance with costs of the King High Remembers program, a Veterans Oral History Project.
