



**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Fair Housing Council of Riverside County will sponsor their Champions for Justice Event which promotes awareness for the work of the Fair Housing Council and the net proceeds of said event allow the agency to continue to provide services to the residents of the Second District.
2. The donation to the Inland Empire Hispanic Leadership Council will be used to fund their community leadership series, scholarships and their annual summit which focuses on business, education, health and public policy.
3. The donation to the West Coast Blues Committee will be used to sponsor the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual West Coast Blues Festival which attracts more than 2,000 people and promotes Blues as an important American musical art form.
4. The donation to the United Way of the Inland Valleys will support their FIT Academies which are designed for current and former foster youth. The academies are six weeks in length, followed by a six-month savings practicum where participants gain essential financial and character development knowledge and resources to implement within their lives, thus increasing self-sufficiency and self-esteem, producing productive and healthy members of our community.
