



**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Children's Primary Care Medical Group - \$2,500 the funding will be used to give new books to children for their well child visit between 6 months and 5 years of age.
2. EXCEED -\$2,000 the funding will be utilized for replacement of commercial refrigerator at Casa del Valle Residential Facility. The facility provides a safe and healthy living environment in which adults with developmental disabilities can learn skills to enhance their independence and participate in their local community.
3. Salute to Veterans Parade Committee - \$1,000 the funding will be used for the necessary professional services to put on a parade that honors and recognizes all local active duty and retired veterans in Riverside County.
