

4. League of United Latino American Citizens (LULAC) of Riverside Council #3190 annual funding will be used for the 8th Annual LULAC of Riverside Health Fair/Clinic. This health/clinic will provide those in need, uninsured and under-insured with the following free services: dental treatments, eye exams and glasses, medical exams and treatments, as well as inform the community of free and low cost medical services available.
5. Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce will be utilizing their annual support for their operations and services that will help promote economic improvement to better serve and assist the community at large.
6. Riverside County Black Chamber of Commerce annual support will assist with services and operations that will increase economic conditions in the community such as business resources, educational programs and developmental skills through the 2018 Multi-cultural Biz Fest.
7. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee annual support will be used for programs, operations and equipment to honor the service and sacrifice of Veterans and to construct a Native American Warrior Memorial and burial site.
8. Saint Christopher's Food Pantry support will assist with providing food service assistance to needy families in the Moreno Valley community.
9. Soroptimist International of Moreno Valley support will be used for improving the lives of women and girls through programs leading to social and economic empowerment through their two signature programs, "Live your Dream: Education and Training Awards" and "Dream It Be It, Career Support for Girls".
