BACKGROUND:

Summary

The California Tobacco Control Program (CTCP) is a program of the California Department of Public Health leading the fight to keep tobacco out of the hands of youth, help tobacco users quit, and ensure that all Californians can live, work, play, and learn in tobacco-free environments. In November 1998, Californians approved a 25-cent tax on cigarettes, and The Tobacco Tax and Health Protection Act (Proposition 99) dedicated 5 cents of the 25-cents to fund California's tobacco control efforts. In November 2016, Californians overwhelmingly voted for Proposition 56, a ballot initiative to raise the tax on tobacco products, increasing the state's tobacco tax by \$2 per pack.

The Department of Public Health has received the Local Lead Agency (LLA) Agreement for Proposition 99 and Proposition 56 funds from the California Department of Public Health – California Tobacco Control Program for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 in the amount of \$1,108,518. The projected funding amount for July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021 is \$3,199,108. Since tobacco funding is an allocation, funding is formulated and may fluctuate based on projected tobacco tax revenue. Therefore, the actual funded amount is not known until receipt of the yearly allocation agreement.

The California Health and Safety Code, Section 104400 (a) (1) states that local health departments are considered the local lead agency. The 2017-2021 LLA Comprehensive Tobacco Control Plan Guidelines state as a LLA, the local health department is required to accept these funds. The program letter 18-04 states that the California Department of Public Health does not require a Board of Supervisors Resolution for allocation agreements. The state requires the official agency signatory identified in the Online Tobacco Information System (OTIS) to sign the allocations agreements, which, for the County of Riverside, is the Director of Public Health.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The California Department of Public Health – California Tobacco Control Program mission is to improve the health of all Californians by reducing illness and premature death attributable to the use of tobacco products, with the overall goal of a tobacco free California. As the LLA, Riverside County Department of Public Health will work to implement local tobacco plans to prevent the use and to promote smoking cessation in-order to improve the health of Riverside County residents.


