

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **League of United Latin American Citizens of Riverside Council #3190 - \$1,500** funds will be used to assist the 5th Annual Free Community Health Fair. At this event, located in the 1st District, participants will receive free dental, vision and medical services. Up to 1,500 participants are expected to attend.

2. **Community Outreach Ministry - \$500** funds will be used to benefit their Annual Angel Tree Christmas Tree Project which will provide food and clothing to 200+ at-risk and/or needy children (ages 0-18) whose parents are incarcerated, as well as provide them with a holiday meal.

3. **California Riverside Ballet - \$1,500** funds will be used to assist with student tuition for The Academy Program, a dance training program for underserved youth, at the Ysmael Villegas and Arlanza Community Centers.
