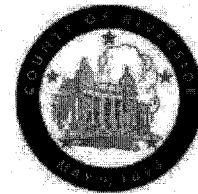

BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the 100 Mile Club will help them continue their efforts in preventing childhood inactivity and obesity by engaging and empowering kids and families to achieve a healthy lifestyle through physical activity one child, one school and one community at a time. The 100 Mile Club encourages kids to walk or run 100 miles throughout the school year. Students can earn awards based on the number of miles they complete in a year.
2. The donation to the California Riverside Ballet will sponsor the 27th annual "Ghost Walk" which is a celebration of the arts through dance and storytelling and includes a kid's carnival on the Main Street Mall in Downtown Riverside.
3. The donation to Rogue Techs will be used to purchase supplies and materials to build a competitive robot for competition. In addition it will help purchase the needed tools for the students to use to build their robot.
4. The donation to Starship Robotics will be used to compete in FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) which is a STEM program designed to engage high school students in engineering activities by combining the excitement of sport with the rigors of science and technology.
