



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. 100 Mile Club, Inc. - \$2,500 the funding will be used to help prevent and reduce obesity in children by making fitness opportunities available in schools, empowering kids to achieve a healthy lifestyle they can maintain.

1. Temecula Sunrise Rotary Foundation - \$1,000 the funding will be used for food supplies for the 24th Annual Community Christmas Dinner, which is free for the public.

2. The Unforgettables Foundation - \$2,500 the funding will be utilized to financially assist low-income families with funerals and burials for their children under 18 years old in Riverside County.

3. Temecula Valley Conservatory of the Arts - \$2,500 the funding will be used to purchase string instruments to start a beginning string program for 5th grade students at Vintage Hills Elementary School.
