Wolf, a 70-year-old longtime resident of Riverside, California who passed away on October 21, 2018.

Born on August 19, 1948 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, Bob was a "giant among giants" and will always be remembered for his integrity, generosity, and humility. Before his long career as a developer active in local and state politics, his service began as a combat medic in the Vietnam War. It was his medical complications from that service, where he was highly decorated, that led to his unexpected death.

An inspirational force in the community, Bob started his company Germania with a broom in hand and worked his way through the ranks to Presidency. He was a Moreno Valley Planning Commissioner, Riverside County Flood Control Commissioner, and served as Chairman of the California Transportation Commission. For nearly a decade, he was Undersecretary for the Transportation for the Business, Transportation and Housing Agency under Governor Pete Wilson.

Bob was instrumental in leading Moreno Valley to Cityhood in 1984. He served on The Valley Group, an organization that advocated the area. He was a leader in helping rally people and in getting the facts on how the City could perform and pay its bills. He believed that the best government was the government closest to the people. He also successfully campaigned for Republican candidates and was Campaign Finance Chairman for Ken Calvert, R-Corona.

Despite his physical challenges and limitations, Bob fought like a warrior and kept a positive attitude while encouraging others. He was a loving and devoted family man, mentor, and friend whose memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be greatly missed but never forgotten.
