BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Department of Environmental Health is responsible for oversight and enforcement in multiple areas including solid waste collection and service.

Ordinance 745 was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on November 29, 1994 as item 3.5. It has been revised only twice since that time, with the last revision occurring on March, 30, 2004 as item 16.1.

Ordinance 745 addresses the comprehensive collection of trash within the unincorporated areas of Riverside County. Some elements of the ordinance has been superseded by the creation of franchise agreements governing waste hauling in the unincorporated County. Other elements of the ordinance require a revision to so that it does not conflict with other department's policies and procedures.

The Department of Environmental Health desires to amend Ordinance 745 to update it as necessary, remove outdated or superseded language and incorporate language from Ordinance 657 to consolidate solid waste collection oversight into one ordinance.

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt an order initiating an amendment of Ordinance 745.
