BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to Soroptimist International of Riverside will be used to sponsor their annual "Live Your Dream Conference" which is an all-day event designed to inspire seventh and eighth grade girls to live their dream by introducing them to women in various professions, such as finance, technology, medical, science and government.
2. The donation to the Family Service Association will be used to sponsor two programs: The HOPE for the Holidays Program which provides holiday gifts to youth in foster care and a program that provides holiday toys and gifts to needy families at the Norton Younglove Community Center.
3. The donation to Catholic Charities will help them provide homeless prevention services to families in the region. The main focus of the program is to help low-income families regain stability after an unexpected financial crisis.
4. The donation to Kids Court and Counseling Center will be used provide counseling for children who must testify in criminal, juvenile dependency and family law matters. The organization also provides free therapy to children who are victims of crime.
