



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County Transportation Department (Transportation Department) is planning on overlaying or reconstructing several existing paved roads in the Thermal Area, Hemet Area, Anza area and Mead Valley area using the department's in-house construction crews.

This work can be efficiently and cost effectively completed using Transportation Department crews, compared to the traditional bidding process. It should be noted that the Transportation Department contracts out the vast majority of its construction work to private contractors (over 90% last year).

Certain projects that are less complex and of a maintenance nature can be more efficiently and quickly accomplished using Department road crews, due to the time and cost savings realized through not having to generate engineered plans and contract specifications, surveying, and inspection costs.

*New Construction

Assembly Bill 720 (AB720) sets forth modified requirements by which new road construction and road reconstruction can be performed by employees of a public agency. Under AB720, an agency may elect to utilize public employees to perform force account work, provided this work does not exceed 30% of the total value of all work performed by force account other than maintenance, as reported in the State Controller's Streets and Roads Annual Report as of January 1 of each year. The intent to use this authority must be declared prior to commencing the work.

The proposed projects with their associated construction budgets are listed in Attachment A-1. The total cost of the work is \$3,832,000.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proposed projects will reduce dust and erosion, and improve access to local residents.

Additional Fiscal Information

The Thermal area paving will be funded by Gas Tax/HUTA funds (\$1,685,000) and Measure A/Coachella Valley funds (\$1,229,000).

The Hemet area paving will be funded by Gas Tax/HUTA funds (\$433,000).

The Anza area paving will be funded by Gas Tax/HUTA funds (\$252,000).


The Mead Valley area paving will be funded by Gas Tax/HUTA funds (\$233,000)



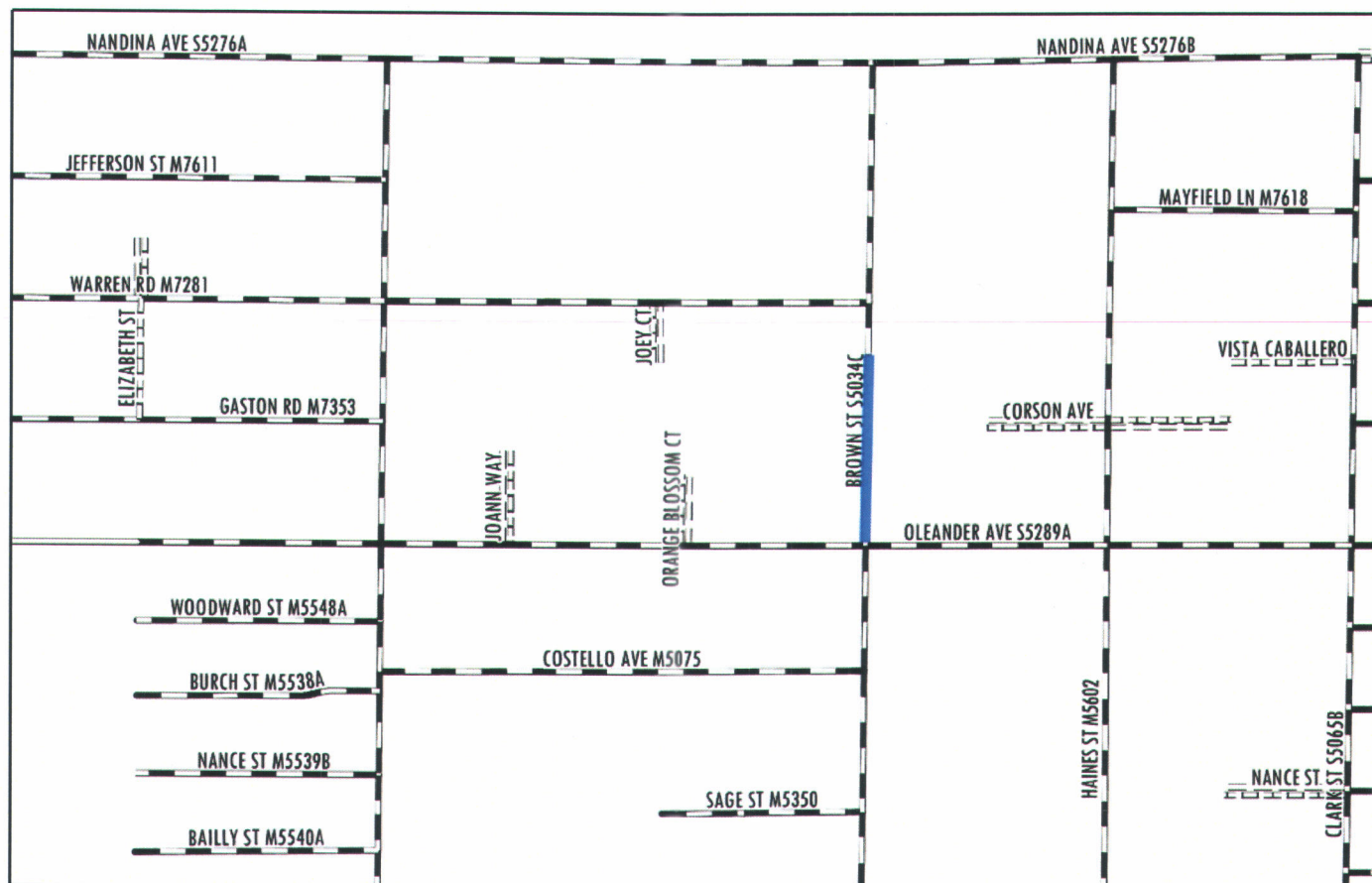
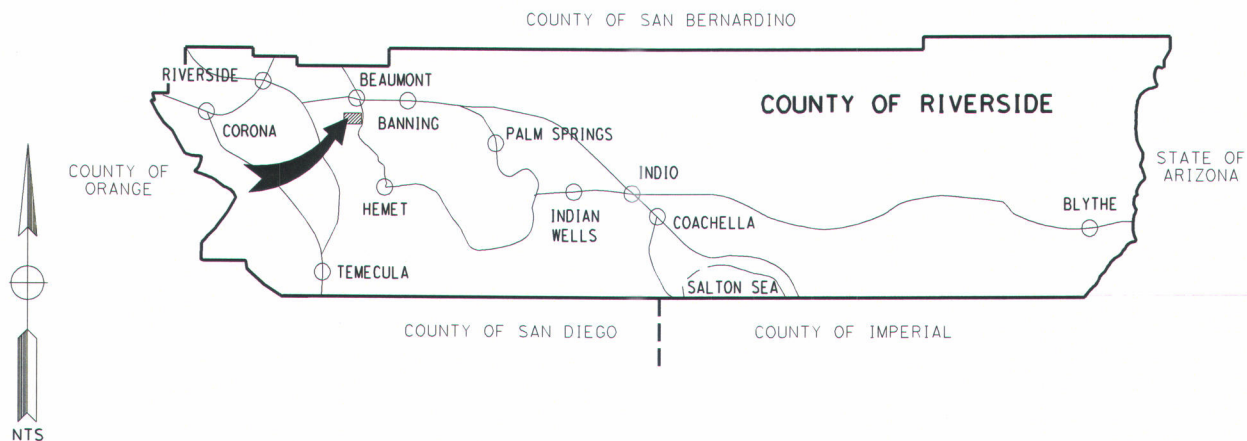

MEAD VALLEY AREA RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

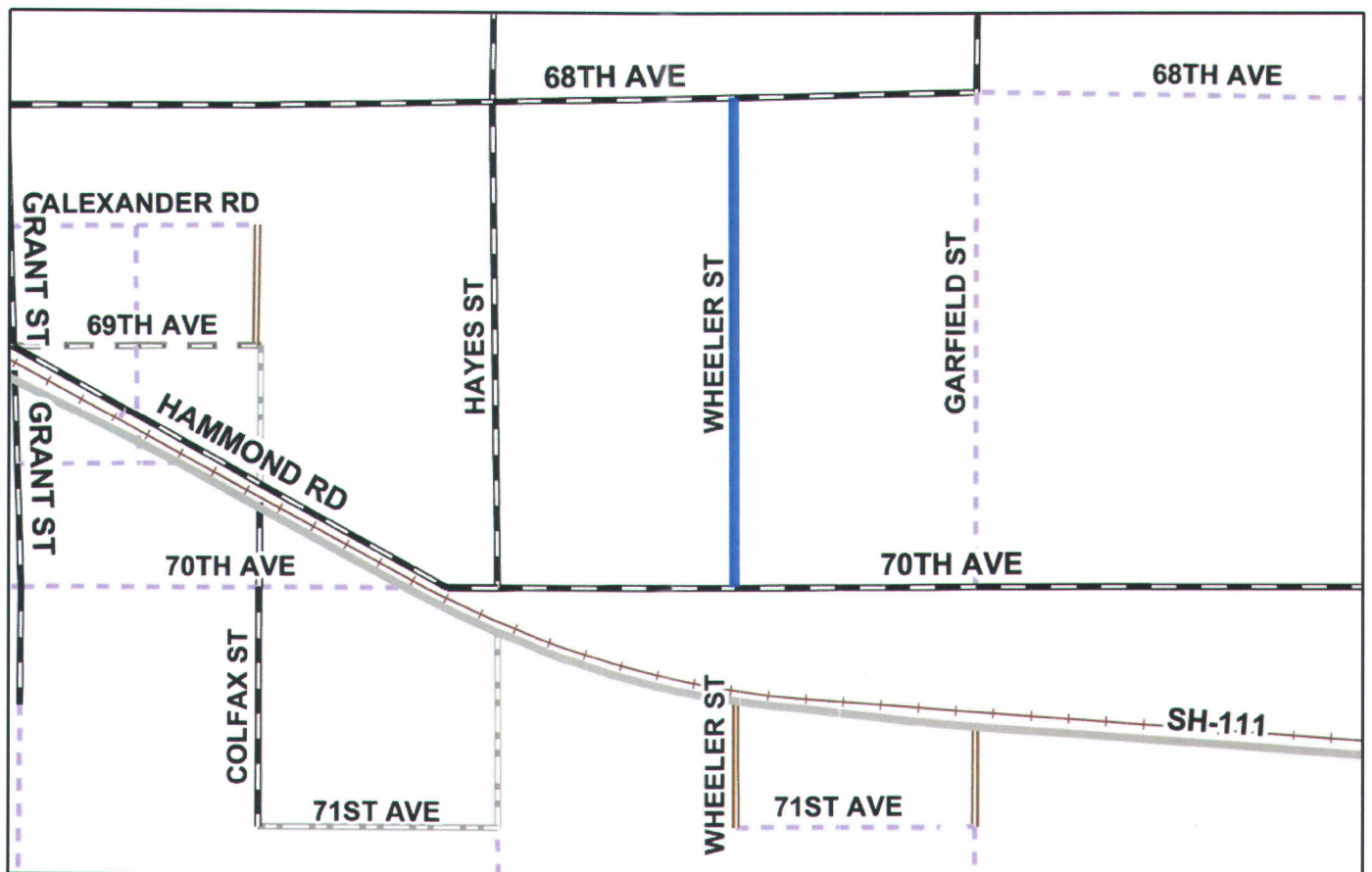
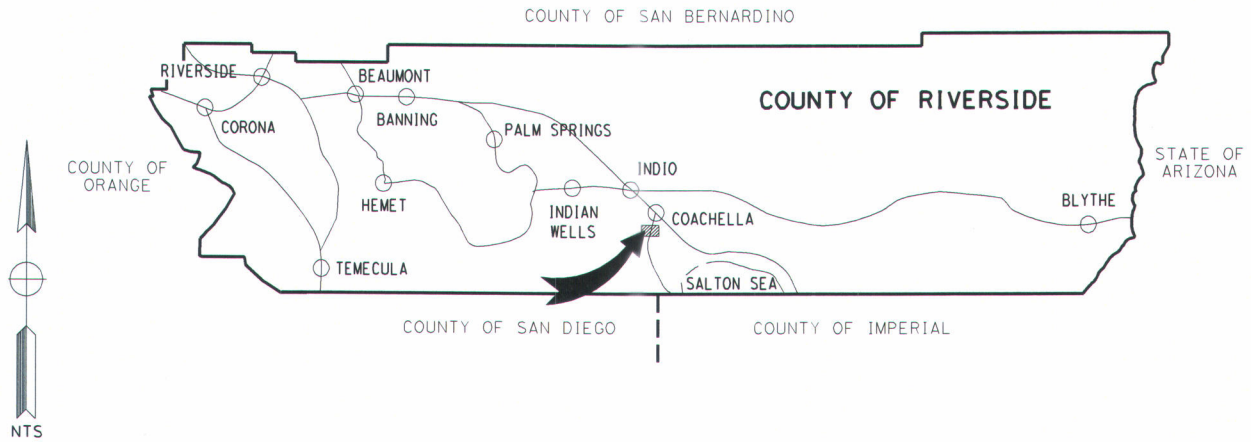


TOWNSHIP 3S RANGE 4W

RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

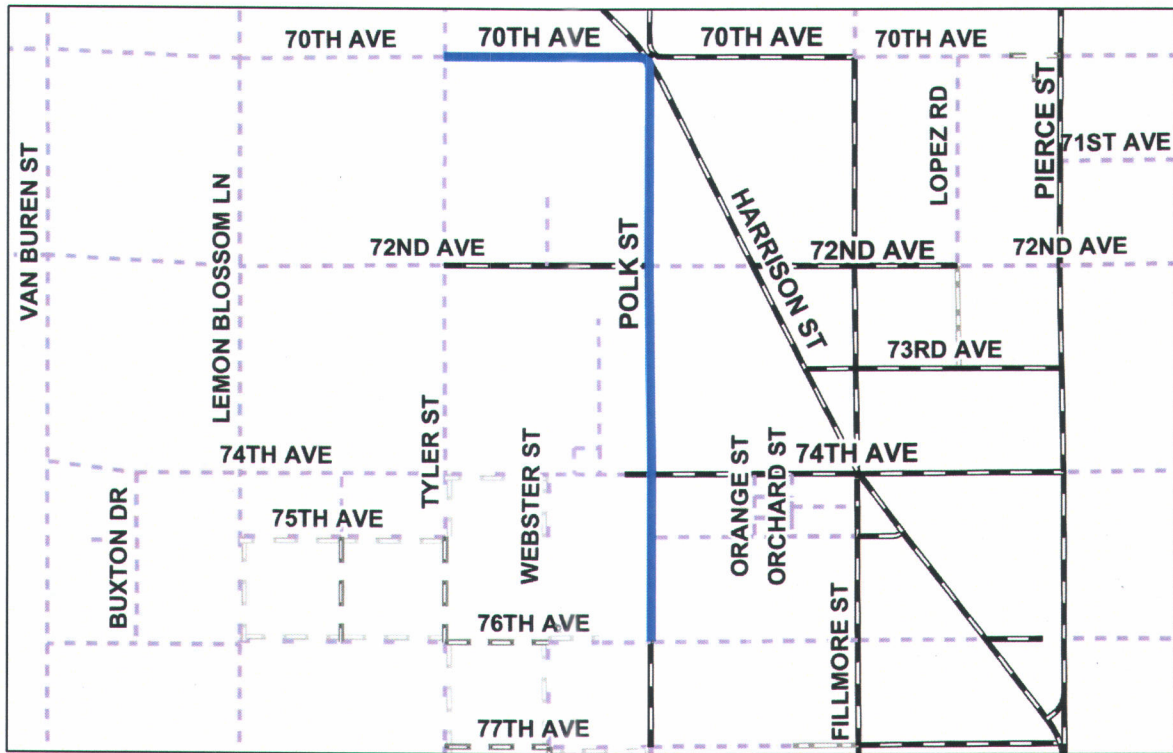
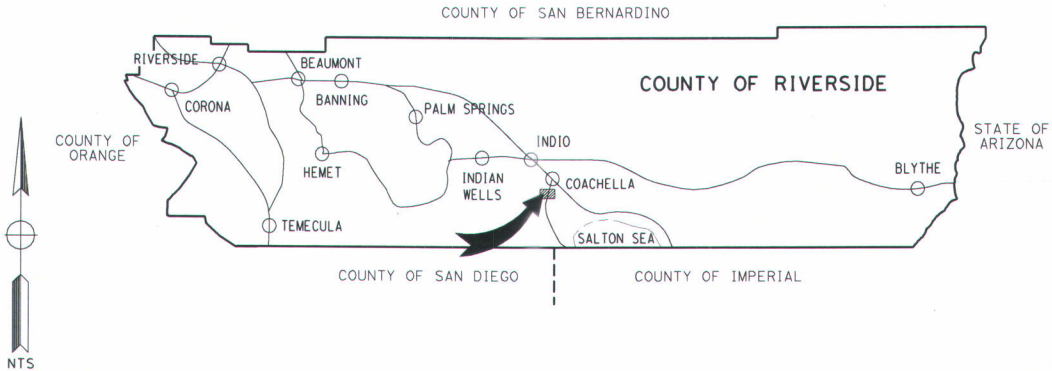


TOWNSHIP 7S RANGE 9E

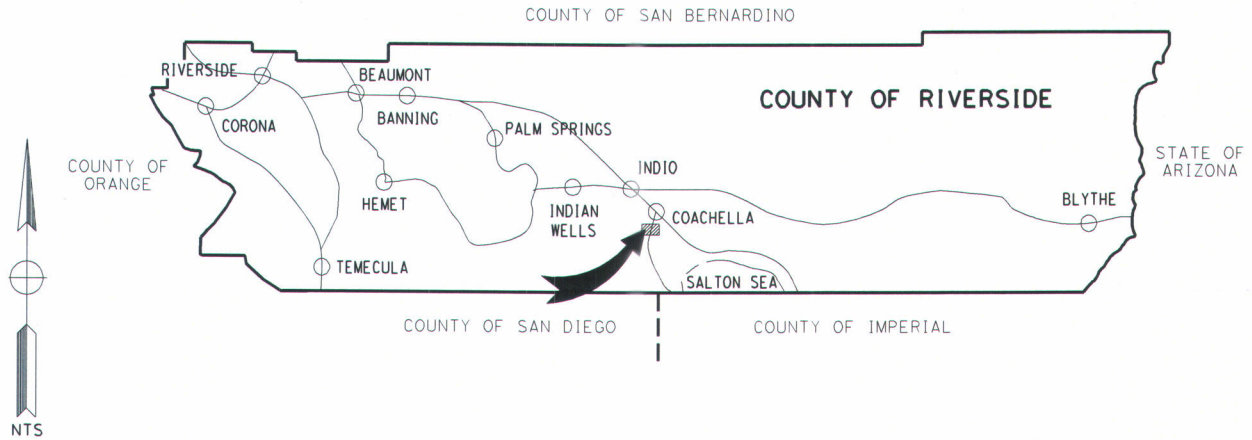


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VICINITY MAP

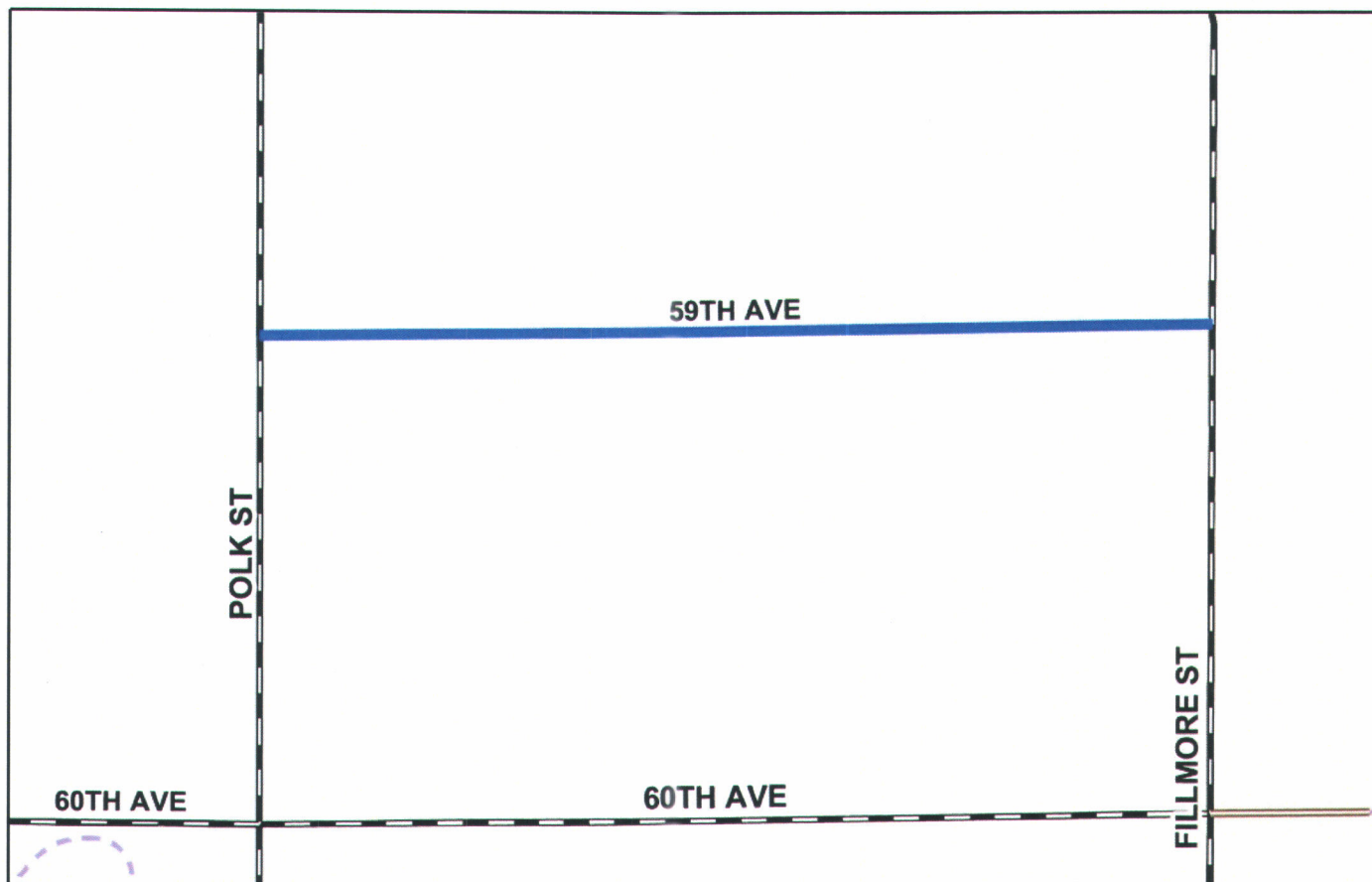
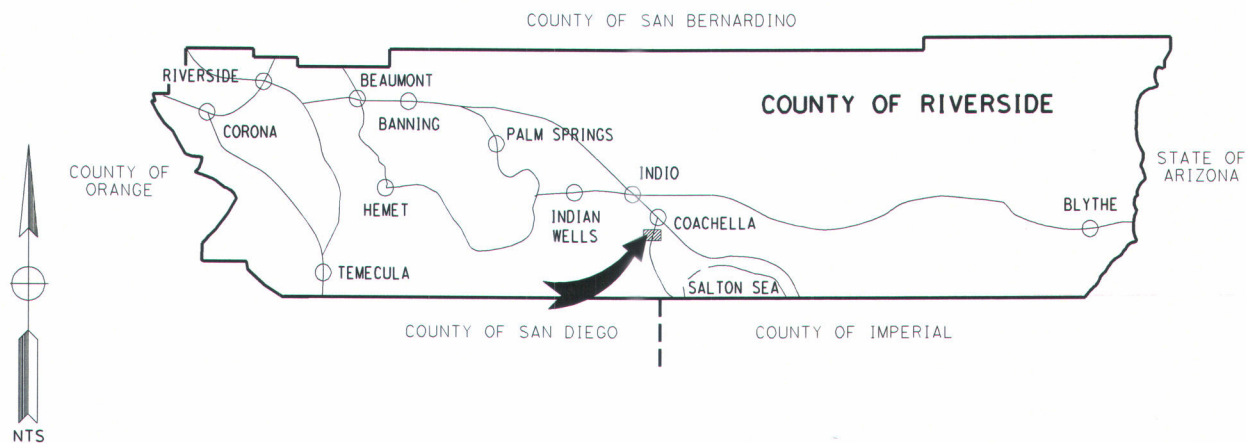


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VICINITY MAP

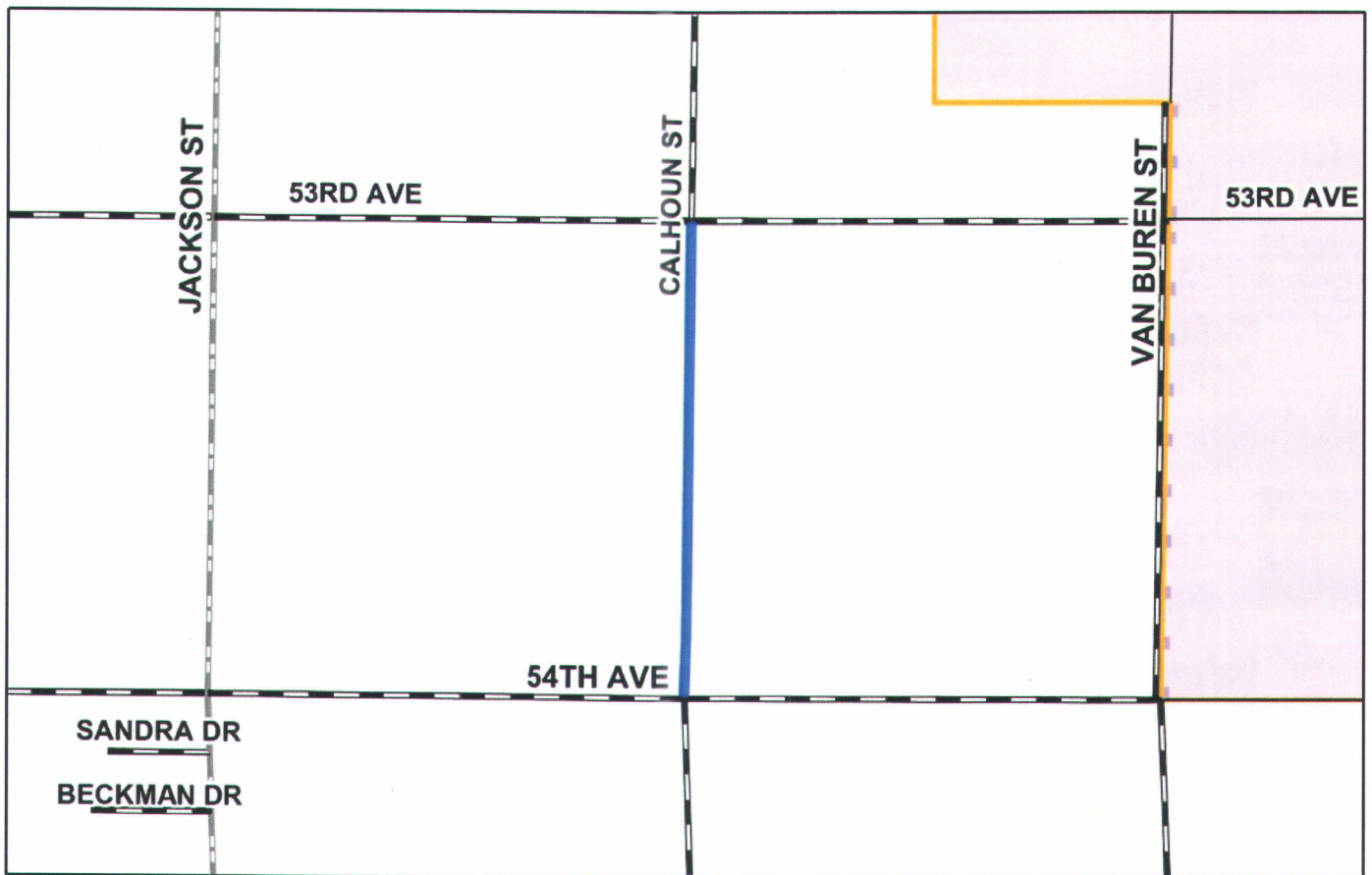
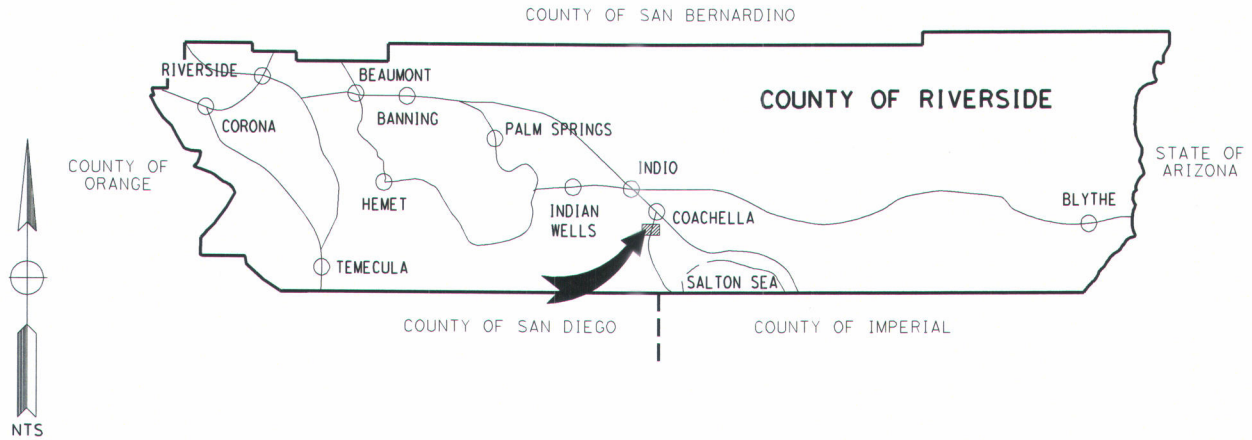


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VICINITY MAP

RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

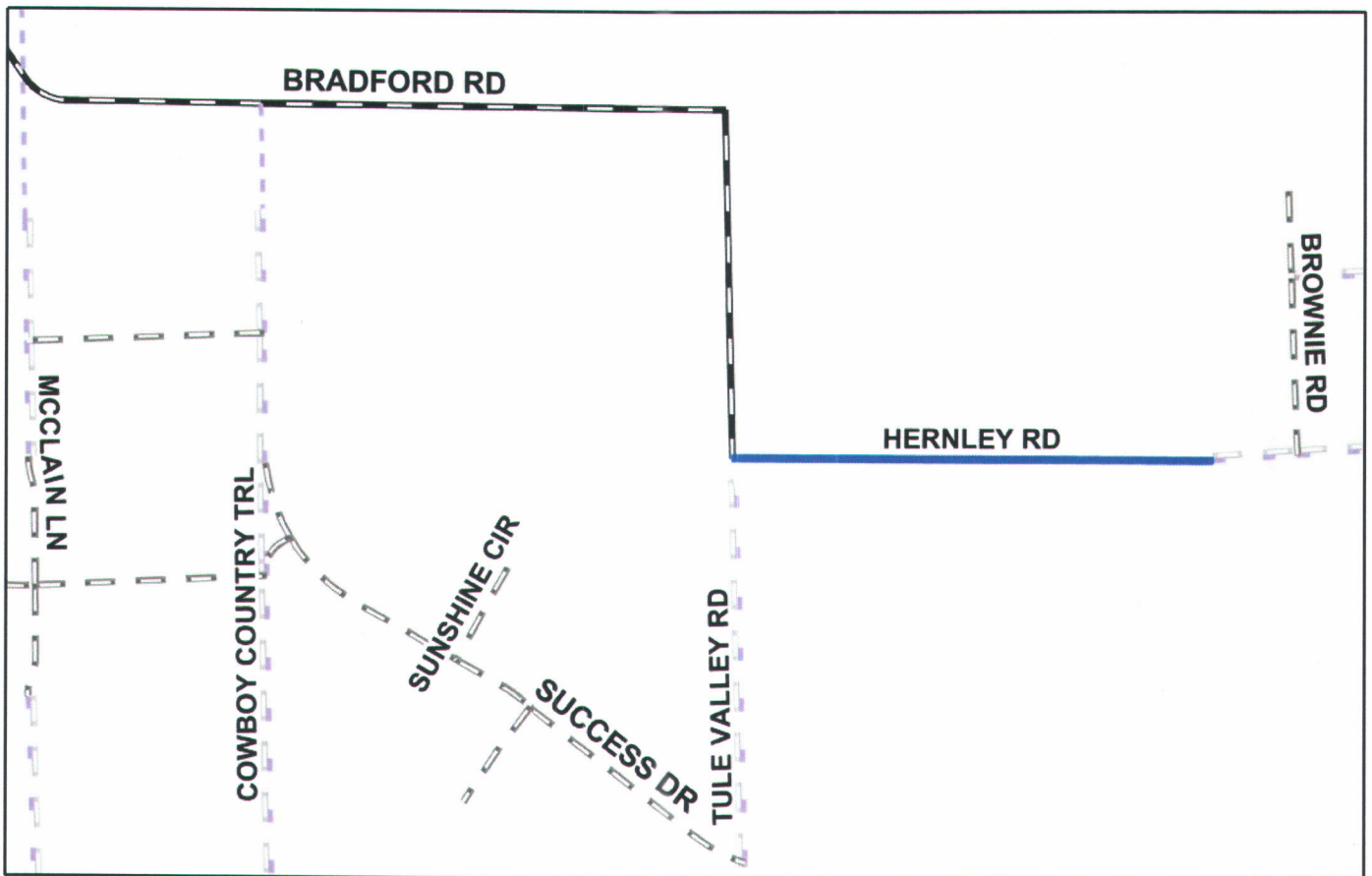
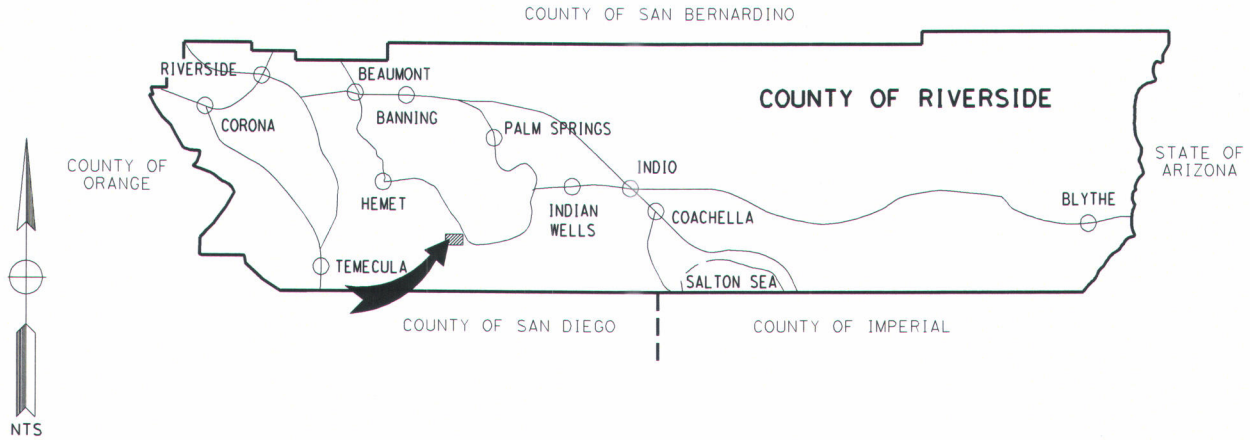


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VICINITY MAP

RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

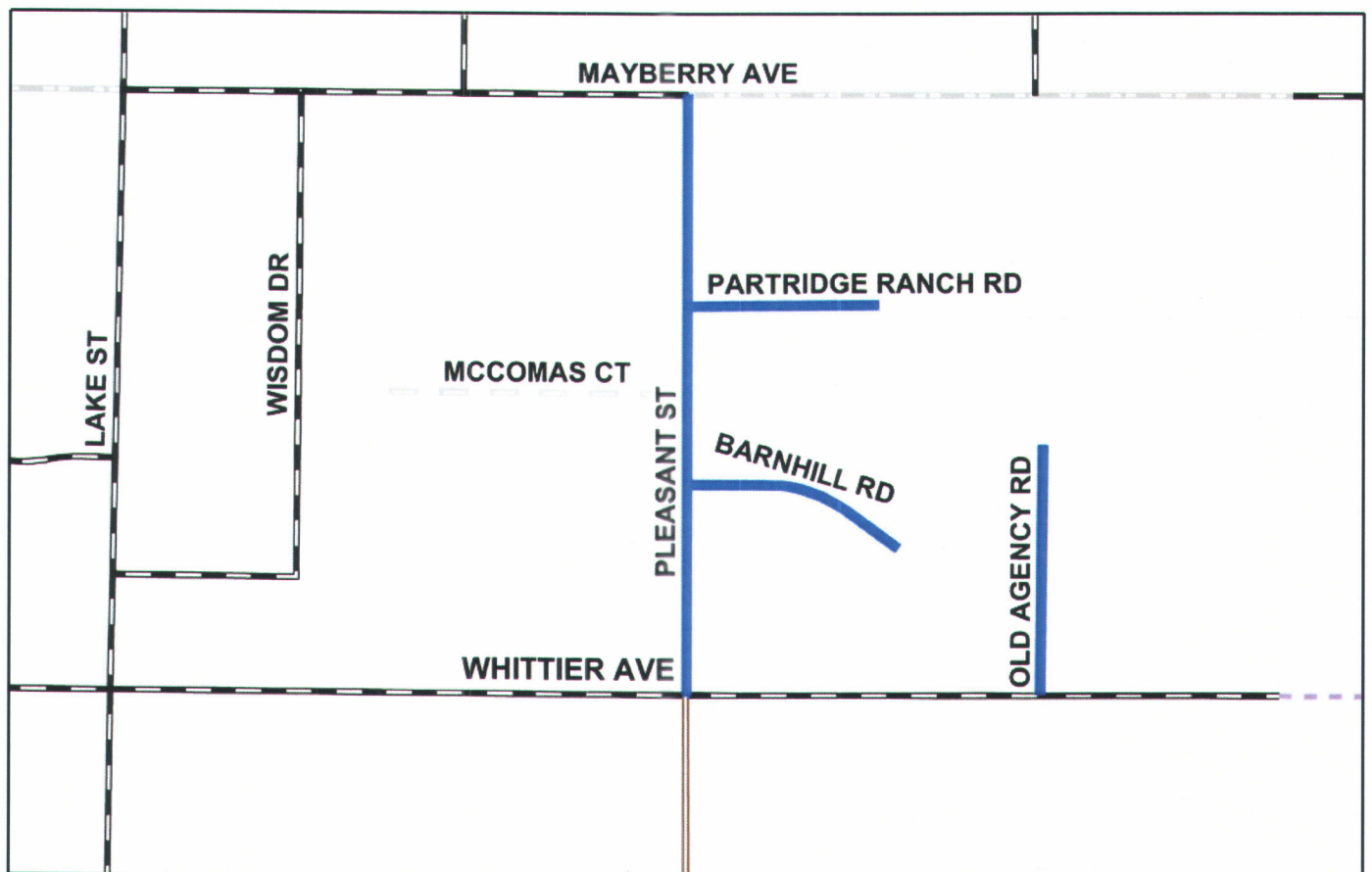
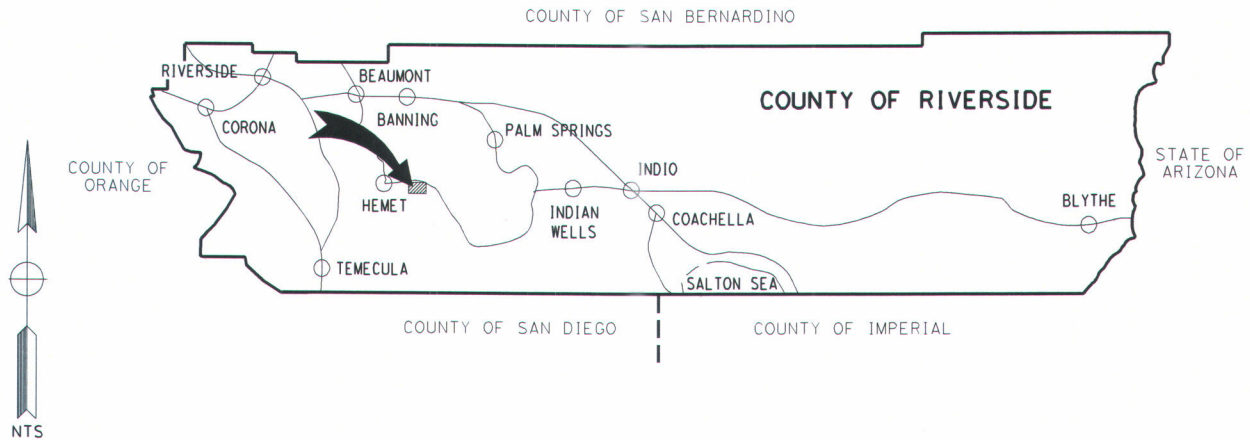


TOWNSHIP 8S RANGE 2E
