

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Box Canyon Road Storm Damage Repair Work is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15269 (d) – Emergency Projects and 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities; and,
2. Approve the Specifications for the construction of the Box Canyon Road Storm Damage Repair Work approximately eight (8) miles of roadway east of the All American Canal near the Community of Mecca; and,
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 28, 2018 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

Recent storm events have resulted in flash floods that have destroyed approximately eight (8) miles of Box Canyon Road easterly of the All American Canal near the Community of Mecca. Box Canyon Road is a scenic, lightly traveled road that runs through a narrow ravine between the community of Mecca and Interstate 10, and serves as an alternate connection to Interstate 10, provides access to multiple trailheads in the Canyon, and becomes Cottonwood Springs Road north of Interstate 10 to Joshua Tree National Park. On a typical day an average of 40 vehicles per day traverse Box Springs Canyon Road.

County Transportation crews closed the roadway on September 30, 2018, after the first flash flood event, and begin the work to cleanup and reopen the roadway. However, due to a search and rescue operation dedicated to finding a missing person in the area, repair work did not start until October 9, 2018. On October 12, 2018, a second storm event further damaged and destroyed 8 miles of Box Canyon Road. The damage is severe and beyond the capabilities of County road crews to repair.

An emergency contract was considered; however, the initial cost estimate is significantly greater than the current \$500,000 limited amount delegated to the Director of Transportation by Resolution No. 2018-009.

In order to expedite the opening of Box Canyon Road the Transportation Department proposes to acquire an Emergency limited force account in the amount of \$3,000,000 to grade and stabilize the roadway, so it can be re-opened to traffic. The contractor will be required to grade a new road alignment and stabilize the roadbed, the road will not be paved. Contractors will competitively bid by proposing markup percentage rates on the contractor's labor, equipment and material. This method of bidding is the quickest way to get a contractor on site to start making the needed repairs. Producing design plans could delay the start of work by 3 months due to the large amount of unknowns that exist. The majority of the roadway is non-existent within the walls of the Canyon and is either buried in whole or in pieces, and the portions that remain may not be salvageable.

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

Repair work will include the following tasks:

1. Emergency work assessment meeting at project location,
2. Mobilization and demobilization,
3. Grading and earthwork,
4. Stabilize roadway,
5. Disposal of excess excavation or unusable materials,
6. Traffic control (changeable message sign boards, road closure signs, delineators, etc.),
7. Additional work as necessary and as directed by the Engineer.

The Specifications and Contract Documents, including exhibits, for this repair work have been approved as to legal form by County Counsel.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the responsible bid for the lowest conformed bid cost based on proposed force account markup percentages.

Environmental Findings

CEQA Guidelines Section 15269 (d) statutorily exempts emergency repairs to existing roads damaged by flood and storm events. In addition, Box Canyon Road repairs are maintenance of an existing road, and is consistent with CEQA Section 15301 (c), which categorically exempts repair and maintenance.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

Box Canyon Road between the All American Canal and the Interstate 10 freeway has been closed since September 30, 2018 and additional storm water on October 12, 2018 has worsened the roadway damage. The cost to replace 8 miles of washed out roadway through the Canyon was estimated at approximately \$7-8 million and was deemed to be unfeasible at this time, due to the frequency of washouts from flash flooding in the Canyon. The new road will be an unpaved road.

The work is scheduled to begin in January 2019 and scheduled for 60 calendar days and anticipated to be completed by March 2019. The road will remain closed until the repair work is completed.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The estimated amount of this contract, prior to commencement of work, is \$3,000,000. Urgent action needs to be taken to reopen this roadway to the public. This amount may vary as the repair work progresses and if subsequent storms cause additional road damage.

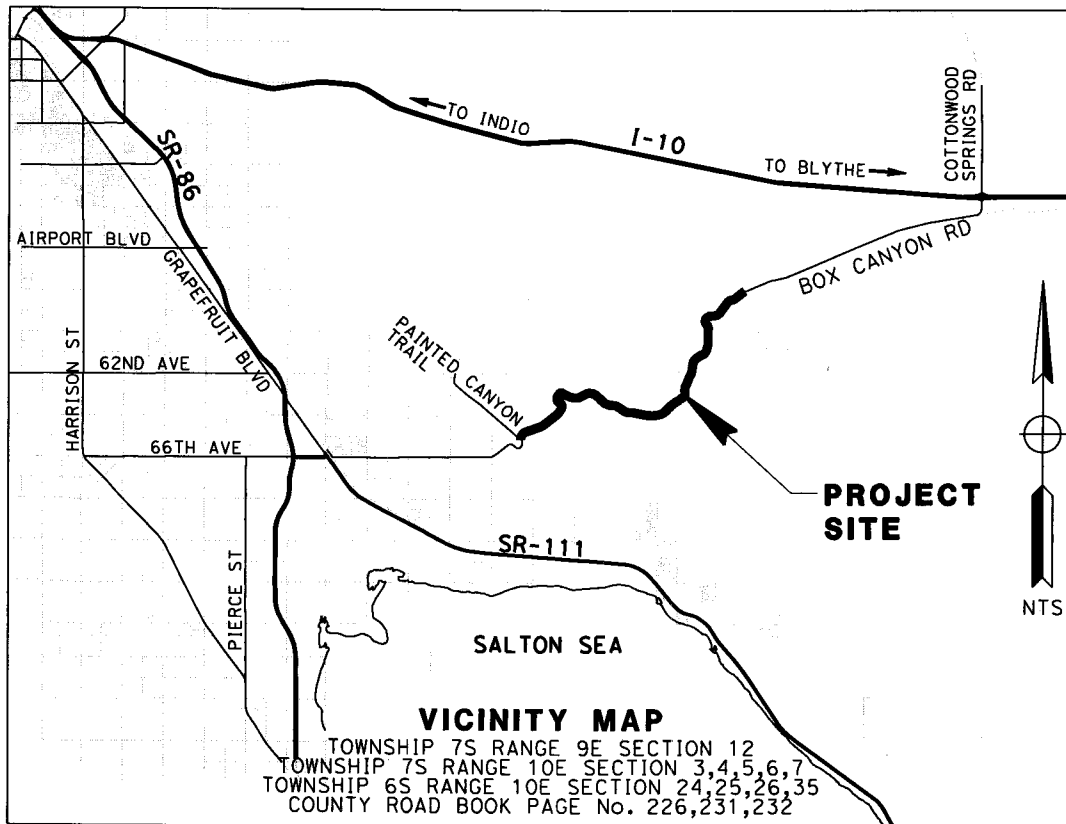
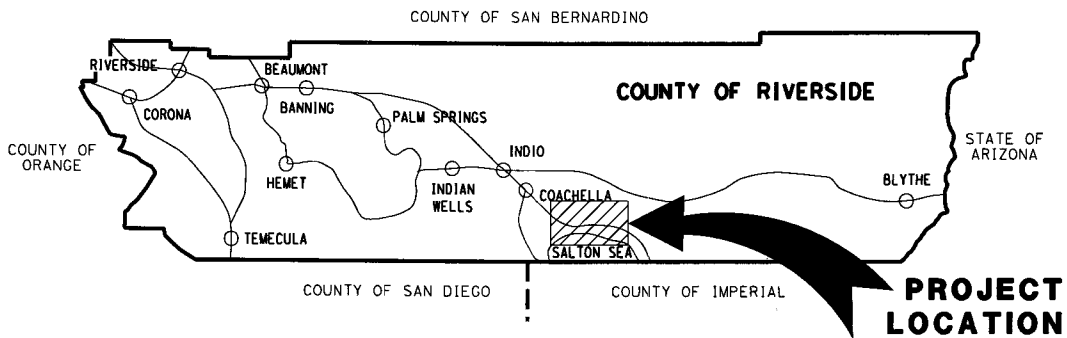

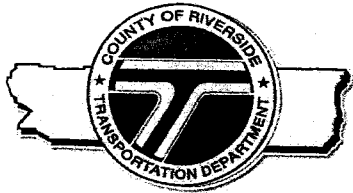

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to restore access through the repair of approximately 8 miles of Box Canyon Road. Box Canyon Road is a two lane facility and is classified as a Secondary Highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Box Canyon Road is approximately 19 miles in length from Garfield Street to the I-10 Interchange, traversing the Mecca Hills Wilderness for approximately 8 miles (Figure 1). The road is located within a desert canyon that is subject to periodic flooding events. Runoff from the Cottonwood Mountains, north of Box Canyon Road, flows through the canyon and ultimately drains into the Salton Sea.

Box Canyon Road was severely damaged after two storm events that took place on September 30th and October 12th, 2018. The majority of the road became impassable following the two flood events, which carried substantial flows of water across the canyon resulting in significant amounts of sediment deposition. Large sections of the road were destroyed or buried. The road lies beneath deposited sediment at unknown depth, with few visible segments of the road.

The proposed work will clear and grade Box Canyon Road for approximately 8 miles. The road will be stabilized. Signage will be replaced as applicable.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The road is an existing two lane facility, which meanders through the undeveloped canyon. Closure of the road prevents visitor access to the Mecca Hills Wilderness area as well as an alternate route to the I-10 freeway. The emergency work is to repair and restore Box Canyon Road to a safe drivable condition. The emergency repair will grade, stabilize, and lay road base for approximately 8 miles on Box Canyon Road following the original alignment as closely as feasible. No additional capacity or improvements will take place beyond what the existing conditions were prior to the storm events. The road is not designated as an official scenic highway. Temporary construction easements may be required.

This emergency repair is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley MSHCP (CVMSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.3.1, specific projects and operation and maintenance activities listed in Table 7-1 through 7-13 are considered Covered Activities. Operation and maintenance of Box Canyon Road is listed as a Covered Activity under Table 7-9, therefore the repair work is considered a Covered Activity under CVMSHCP.

Pursuant to Section 4.4 Avoidance, Minimization and Mitigation Measures of the CVMSHCP, the emergency repair shall comply with the mitigation and minimization measures outlined within the Inactive Season Protocol for Desert Tortoise between November 1 and February 14.

The Riverside County Transportation Department Staff conducted a review of the above referenced and has determined that the proposal qualifies for Statutory and Categorical Exemptions per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines based on the following:

Section 15269(d) – Statutory Exemption for Emergency Projects – Emergency repairs are planned in order to restore access on Box Canyon Road. The road is damaged and buried under sediment that was deposited on Box Canyon Road during two storm events that took place on September 30th and October 12th, 2018. Emergency Projects undertaken, carried out, or approved by a public agency to maintain, repair, or restore an existing highway damaged by flooding is considered exempt from the requirements of CEQA. The project proposes to repair Box Canyon Road due to damage caused by storm events, therefore it is consistent with Section 15269(d) and statutorily exempt from CEQA requirements.

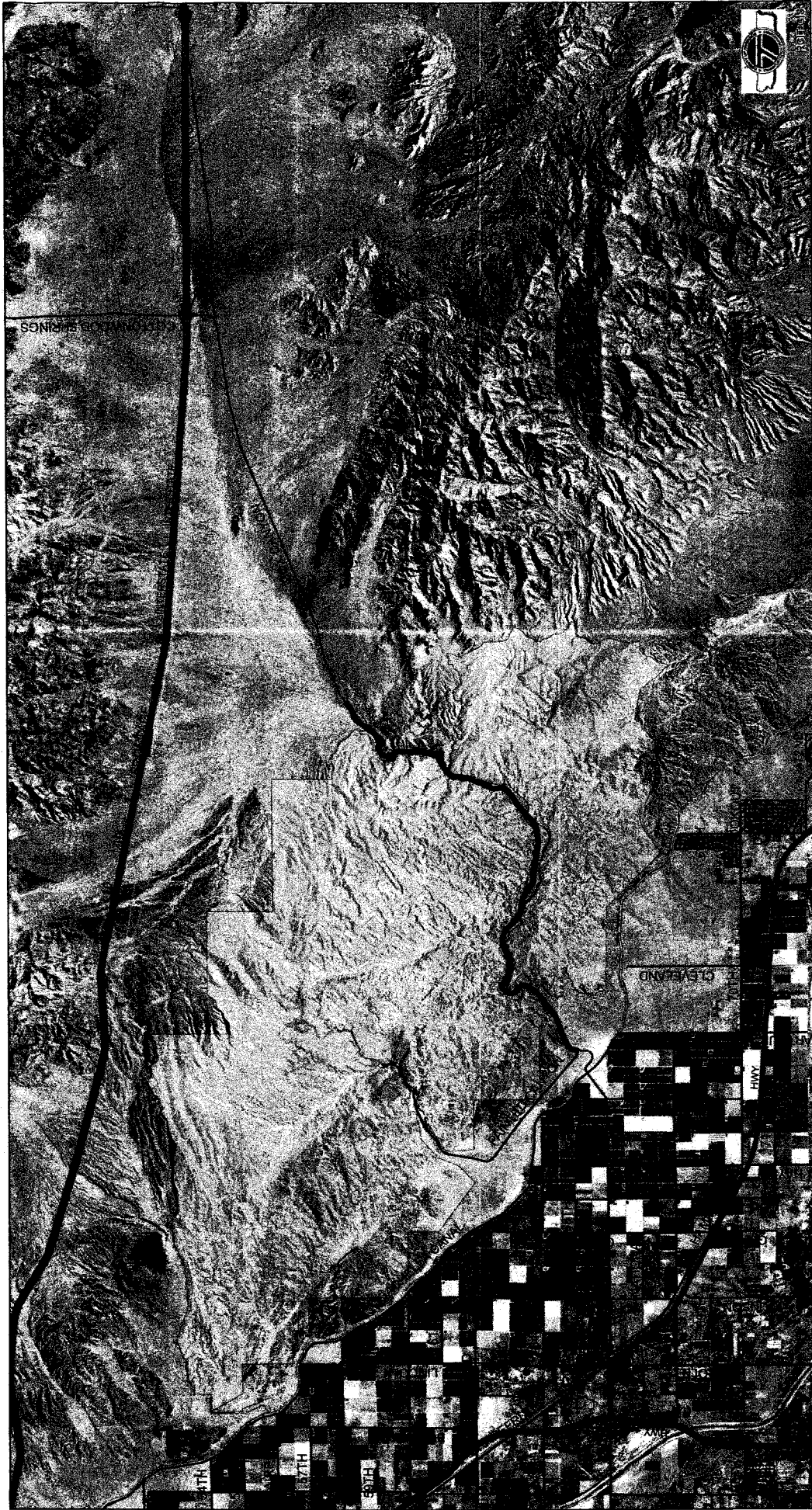
Section 15301(c) – Existing Facilities – The Riverside County proposes to repair Box Canyon Road. This emergency repair to the existing public facility involves negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing prior to the storm events and is categorically exempt from CEQA under Section 15301(c) as a Class 1 activity. The emergency repair is consistent with Section 15301(c) because the work is repair and maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities.

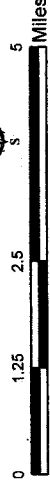


