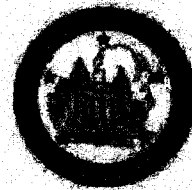





BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Family Service Association - \$1,000 the funding will be used for the Hope for the Holidays program that provides holiday gifts for youth in foster care.
2. Voices - \$1,000 will be used to provide holiday gifts and food supplies for families in the Homeland area.
3. Jacob's House, Inc. – \$2,500 to be used for healthcare hospitality services for families who are experiencing a traumatic medical event. Families stay at Jacob's House when their loved ones have been hospitalized or receiving lifesaving treatments.
4. Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$1,000 the funding will be used to support recognizing community services and contributions of the local business and non-profit organizations in the area.
