#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing improvements by installing traffic signalization and lighting at the "T" intersection of Gilman Springs Road and Bridge Street in the Gilman Hot Springs area of the County. At this intersection, Gilman Spring Road is currently a two lane highway that travels in the northwest-southeast directions with two through lanes and a left-turn lane for northbound vehicles turning southwest onto Bridge Street. Bridge Street is a two-lane facility that travels in the southwest-northeast directions. The area in the immediate vicinity is currently undeveloped.

Project construction will include installing traffic signal poles with mast-arms, safety lighting, and traffic signal cabinets, grading, constructing a retaining wall, installing concrete curb and gutter, and replacing existing traffic striping and signs.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

# **Environmental Findings**

The Gilman Springs Road and Bridge Street Traffic Signal and Lighting Project is a minor alteration of an existing facility. No right-of-way will be required as part of the project. The project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301(c), which describes the minor alteration of existing public facilities. The project will occur on an existing roadway and will not expand the use beyond its existing use and the project will improve safety at the existing intersection through the installation of a traffic signal and safety lighting; consequently, the project qualifies as an exemption under Section 15301(c) of CEQA.

# **Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements.

# **Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$353,588. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2018/2019 and will be funded with West County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.





**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Gilman Springs Road and Bridge Street. Gilman Springs Road is a 2-lane facility that travels in the North-South directions with 12-foot through lanes and 2-foot paved shoulders. Bridge Street is a two-lane facility that travels in the East-West directions with 12-foot wide through lanes and 1-foot paved shoulders. The area in the immediate vicinity is rural agricultural. The project will include the following:

- Installation of traffic signal poles, mast arms, signal cabinets, and pull-boxes
- Installation of video detection for the traffic signals
- Installation of curb and rumble stripe
- Installation of guardrail and retaining wall
- Removal and installation of traffic striping and signs
- Grading and minor paving
- Utility relocations

# **ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within cell criteria areas. This project is within a cell criteria area and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP. The project will comply with the construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities - The project proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Gilman Springs Road and Bridge Street. The project proposes improvements that are consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is a minor alteration that consists of installation of a new traffic signal, retaining wall, guardrail, and repair and maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities with negligible or no expansion of use.
