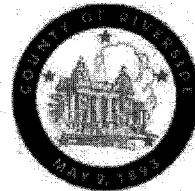

**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Assistance League of Riverside will be used to help fund various programs, including Operation School Bell which provides new school clothes, shoes, backpacks and school supplies for children and teens in need.
2. The donation to the High Desert Community Foundation will help support the Inland Empire Coverage and Health Initiative which will study mental health services and the needs of the community, especially youth and families. The study, which will include portions of the second district, will identify gaps in service and help find solutions to meet the needs.
3. The donation to the Inlandia Institute will help fund free creative writing workshops at the Riverside Downtown Library and the Corona Senior Center.
4. The donation to the Riverside Dickens Festival will be used sponsor their annual festival, which is a three day event which features performances, poetry readings and other events that will attract children.
