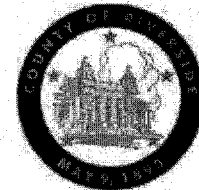



SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION AND LAND MANAGEMENT AGENCY/ TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT: Approval of the Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise for bid for the Slurry Seal Project for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 at various locations; CEQA Exempt, 4th and 5th Districts (Clerk to Advertise). [\$2,196,409]; Local Funds 100%.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the Slurry Seal Projects for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 at various locations in 4th and 5th Districts; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 9, 2019 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Slurry Seal treatment is provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement and postpone more costly pavement rehabilitation. Slurry Seal treatment seals small cracks, restores lost flexibility to the pavement surface and helps preserve the underlying pavement structure. This project includes various roads located within the 4th and 5th Supervisorial Districts. The specific roads are listed in "Attachment 1".

This project proposes Slurry Seal and Microsurfacing treatments based on the existing pavement conditions. Slurry Seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregates, water and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. This work includes road cleaning, crack repairs, application of Slurry Seal treatment, installation of new thermoplastic crosswalks, replacement of striping, pavement markings and raised pavement markers. All roads will be swept several times, at specified intervals, after the slurry has been applied.

The Micro-surfacing treatment is similar to Slurry Seal except it uses polymer modified and fast setting asphalt emulsion allowing thicker layers to be placed. The thick layer application is used to fill in ruts.

This project also includes the improvement of twenty-five (25) existing curb ramps which include reconstruction of seventeen (17) ramps and minor repair of eight (8) ramps. The specific ramps locations are listed in "Attachment 2".

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid: Slurry Seal and associated work on selected County maintained roads.

Alternate Bid Schedule 1: Concrete curb ramps and associated work.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) describes the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of existing public facilities, with negligible or no expansion of an existing facility, to be considered as a categorical exemption under CEQA. This project qualifies under this exemption since it is a repair and maintenance activity taking place on existing County roads. Therefore, the project is exempt from CEQA.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The Slurry Seal treatment will extend the life of the pavement thereby reducing the need for more extensive types of resurfacing that can be up to ten times more costly.

The reconstruction of curb ramps is expected to improve access and safety for disabled persons using the pedestrian facilities along the roadways. In addition, bringing the curb ramps up to current accessibility standards contributes toward fulfilling the County Transportation Department's goals as stated in its ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan as required by Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$2,196,409 and construction is anticipated to be completed in FY 2018/2019. The Slurry Seal contract will be funded with Measure A/Western and Measure A/Coachella Valley Funds.



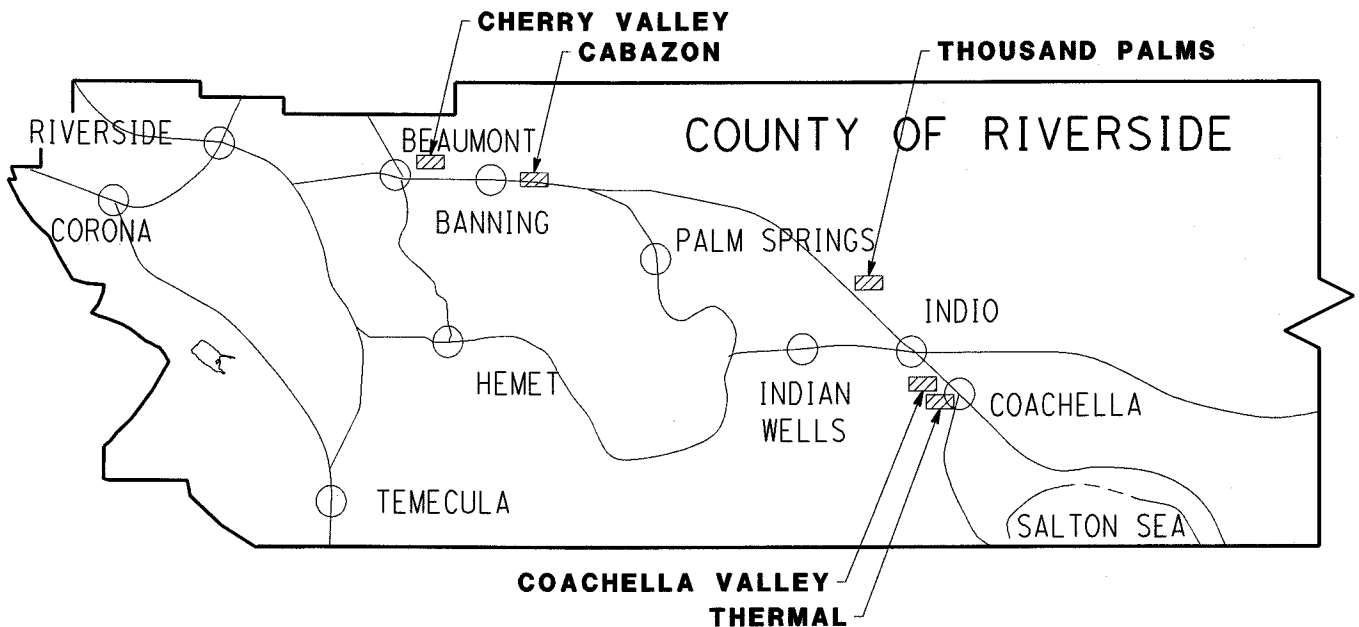

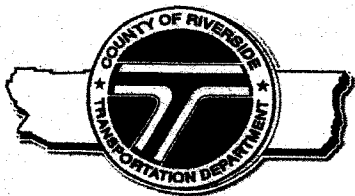

PROJECT LOCATION: Various Locations in Unincorporated areas within Supervisorial Districts 4 & 5

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: 4th and 5th

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to provide slurry seal treatment to existing pavement surfaces on various roads (attachment A) located within Districts 4 and 5 of Riverside County.

Slurry seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of concrete emulsion, aggregate (very small crushed rock), water, and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface. The treatment is provided as preventative maintenance to extend the life of the pavement. The work also involves replacing non-compliant curb ramps, removing and replacing thermoplastic crosswalk and pavement markings, paint traffic stripes and other work as may be required.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project does not require additional right of way nor temporary construction easements. The project will extend the life of the pavement of the treated roads, which is a benefit to the traveling public. The project consists of maintenance and repair of an existing public road. There is no expansion of use of the road as a result of the project.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County and Coachella Valley Multi-Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County and Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside of cell criteria areas. This project is an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to slurry seal various road locations within Districts 4 and 5. These minor improvements to the existing roadways involves no expansion of use and is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c). The improvements are consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is repair and maintenance of an existing road and associated facilities.

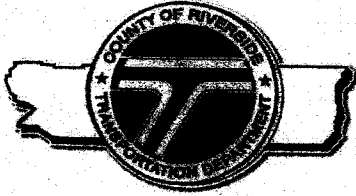

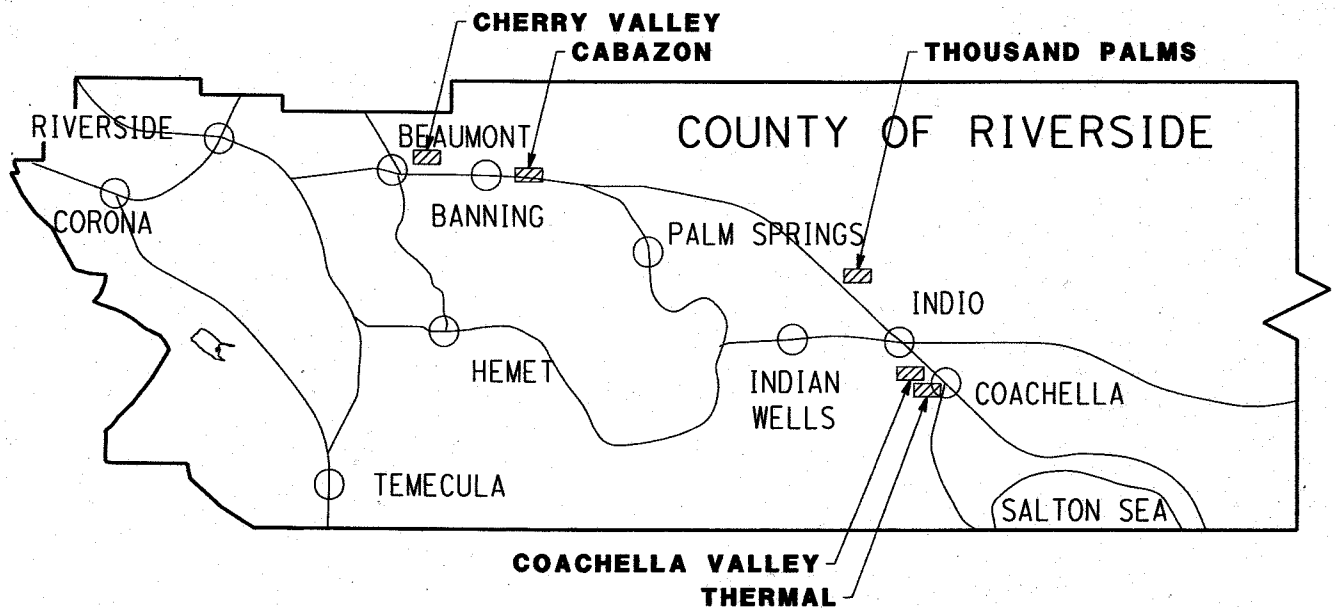
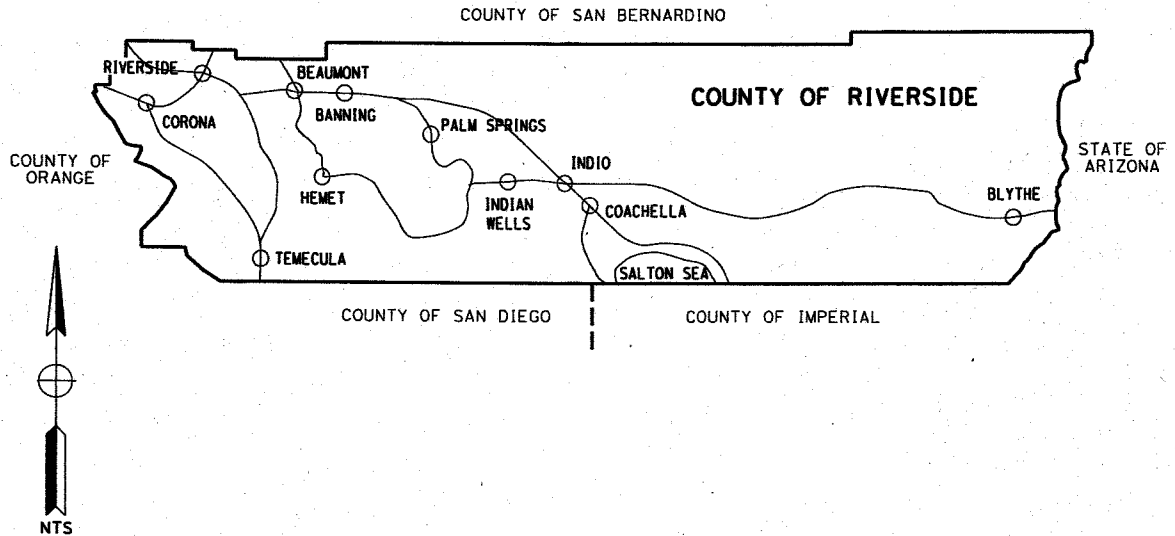
