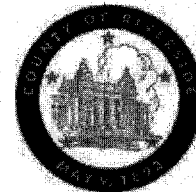



DEPARTMENT: Approval of the Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise for Bids for the North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project Phase 1, in the Cities of Palm Springs and Desert Hot Springs. CEQA Finding of Nothing Further Required; 4th District and 5th District; [\$894,620 Total]; Local Funds 100%. (Clerk to Advertise)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that all potentially significant effects of the North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project have been adequately analyzed in earlier Mitigated Negative Declaration approved by this Board on January 9, 2018 (item 3.32); therefore nothing further is required pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project Phase 1, in the Cities of Palm Springs and Desert Hot Springs; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 6, 2019 at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project from 20th Avenue to Dillon Road, approximately 1.26 miles, in the City of Palm Springs, City of Desert Hot Springs and unincorporated area of the County of Riverside. North Indian Canyon Drive is currently a two lane road that ranges from 40-86 feet wide with curb/gutter and sidewalk along various segments of the roadway and is classified as an Arterial Highway in the County of Riverside General Plan and is a major north-south roadway that provides connectivity to Interstate 10 and State Route 62 in the Cities and communities near Palm Springs and Desert Hot Springs.

Due to the delayed scheduling for relocations of power poles owned by Southern California Edison, and pending completion of right-of-way acquisition on a property located north of 18th Avenue, the Transportation Department has divided the construction of the North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project in two phases:

Phase 1 - Roadway widening from 2 lanes to 4 lanes from 20th Avenue to 18th Avenue.

Phase 2 - Roadway widening from 2 lanes to 4 lanes from 18th Avenue to Dillon Road, and the addition of a traffic signal at Dillon Road. Construction is expected in late 2019, following the relocation of power poles.

The Phase 1 proposed improvements will involve widening the roadway between 8 and 20 feet on either side of the road, expanding North Indian Canyon Drive from one lane in each direction to two lanes in each direction between 20th Avenue and 18th Avenue. Roadway rehabilitation will be included and involves the reconstruction of approximately 900 feet of roadway in the existing northbound lane. The widening will consist of excavating the roadway and placing Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) over Class II Aggregate Base.

Additional improvements include construction of concrete curb and gutter, placement of shoulder backing, utility adjustments, striping of roadway including pavement markers and reflectors, and salvage/removal and installation of new road signs.

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

All needed right-of-way has been acquired to construct the Phase 1 improvements.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule: North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project Phase 1
Alternate Bid Schedule 1: Coachillin Development – North Indian Canyon Drive road widening
Alternate Bid Schedule 2: Mission Springs Water District (MSWD) - Facilities Adjustments

The lots and frontage along the east side of North Indian Canyon Drive between 19th Avenue and 18th Avenue are currently being developed. The development (Coachillin) has already constructed curb and gutter improvements at their ultimate location and are required to widen North Indian Canyon Drive prior to final building approvals. The widening adjacent to the Coachillin Development is being bid as Alternate Bid Schedule 2. Should this widening be completed prior to the County's award of a construction contract, it will not be awarded as part of this construction contract.

If MSWD approves of the award of their respective alternate bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by MSWD through a reimbursement agreement.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

Environmental Findings

At its meeting on January 9, 2018 (Item 3.32), the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors adopted the Final Initial Studies with Mitigated Negative Declarations and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Programs for the North Indian Canyon Drive Widening Project based on the conclusion that the projects will not have a significant effect on the environment. The approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is an implementing action in furtherance of the projects, and no further documentation is required under CEQA.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed widening of North Indian Canyon Drive will improve mobility, reduce congestion, and provide continuity of 4 lanes between the community and Interstate 10.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2019. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

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SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$894,620 and will be funded with Coachella Valley Association of Governments - Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fee funds.



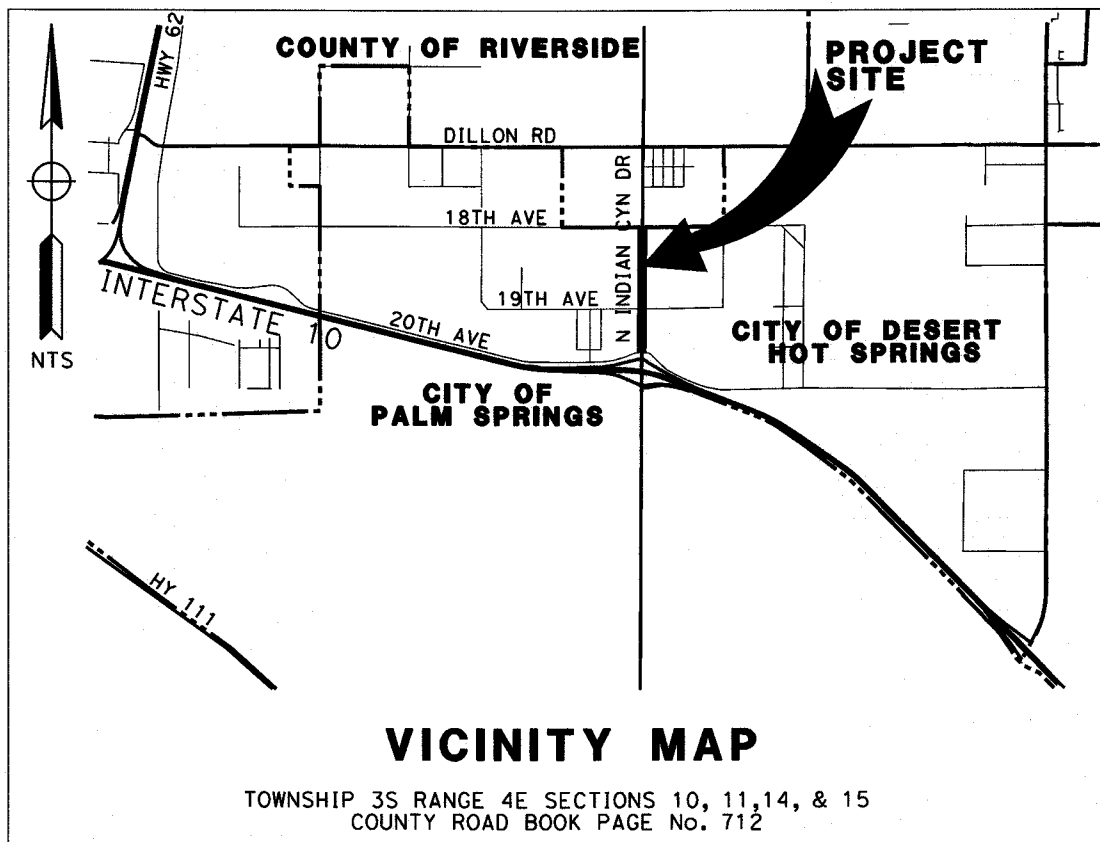
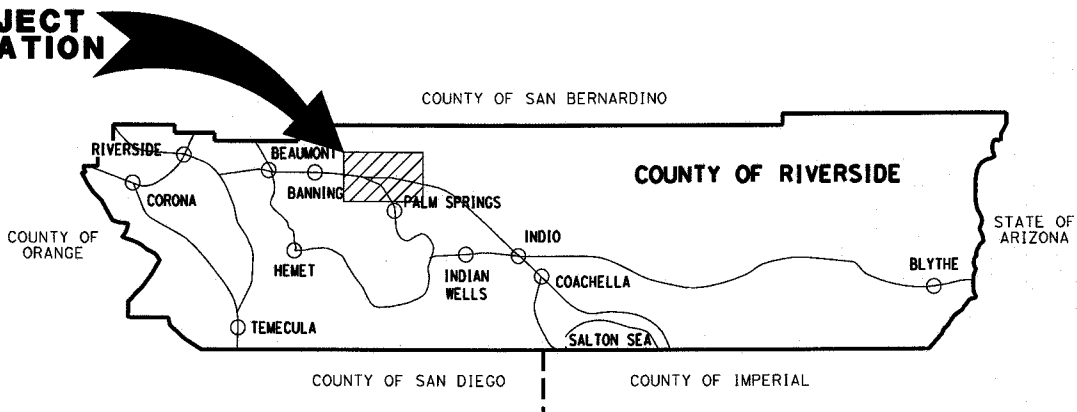

Bid shall be delivered to the County of Riverside Transportation Department, 14th Street Annex, 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501, telephone (951) 955-6780 not later than 2:00 p.m., on Wednesday, **February 6, 2019** to be promptly opened in public at said address. Each bid shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and other contract documents, dated **September 2018**, and prepared by County of Riverside, whose address is same as the above, from whom they may be obtained upon deposit of **\$15.00** per set with 24" x 36" plans plus mailing costs. No refund. Prospective bidders may preview the plans, specifications and other contract documents at no charge prior to purchase at the above noted location.

Pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.1, any Contractor bidding, or subcontractor to be listed on a bid proposal subject to Public Contract Code section 4104, shall not be qualified to bid after March 1, 2015, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. No Contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract or perform work on any contract for public work, after April 1, 2015, without proof of current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 to perform public works.

The County of Riverside, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252) and the Regulations of the Department of Commerce (15 C.F.R., Part 8) and related statutes, issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that minority businesses will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids, and it will affirmatively insure that the contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex, national origin, religion, age, or disability.
