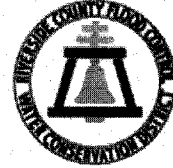



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Board approved a contract with Wright Construction Engineering Corporation (Contractor) in the amount of \$385,547 as Agenda Item Number 11.9 on July 31, 2018.

The District does not anticipate any claims for additional compensation from the Contractor, therefore, the total project construction cost is not expected to exceed the original contract amount.

Final inspection of the above-referenced project was made, and the project was found to be complete according to plans and specifications. A brief project description and location map are attached.

THE PROPOSED MEADOWVIEW STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT IS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF TEMECULA, RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA. THE PROJECT SITE IS GENERALLY BOUNDED TO THE NORTH AND TO THE WEST BY UNDEVELOPED LAND, TO THE EAST BY MEADOWVIEW TRAIL, AND TO THE SOUTH BY DEL REY ROAD. THE PROJECT CONSISTS OF APPROXIMATELY 1,200 LINEAL FEET (4.25 ACRES) OF STREAM STABILIZATION WITH NATIVE VEGETATION AND BIOENGINEERING TECHNIQUES, SUCH AS LAYING BACK CUT BANKS, ADDING ROCK RIPRAP, COMPOST ROLLS, AND HYDROSEED IN ALL DISTURBED AREAS. COMPLETION OF THE MEADOWVIEW STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT WILL IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY, WATER QUALITY AND THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT BY REDUCING BANK EROSION AND RESTORING THE NATIVE HABITAT. THE MEADOWVIEW COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION WILL ASSUME OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROJECT UPON PROJECT COMPLETION.


