

BACKGROUND:

Summary

In 1995 the Regional Park and Open-Space District (Parks) utilized District 1 DA/DM allocations (71%) and Parks funds (29%) to purchase land (APN 362-150-026 & 026) for potential future development into a Regional Park (M.O. 9.1 5/09/1995, M.O. 3.22, 6/20/1995, M.O. 3.34 7/18/1995). Mt. San Jacinto Community College (MSJCC) subsequently expressed interest in purchasing the property for potential development of a college site (M.O. 13.1-3/20/03). The land sale from Parks to MSJCC was finalized and recorded on 6/28/2018 at a purchase price of \$2,630,000.

Since the original purpose of the DA/DM allocation was not fulfilled, the proceeds from the sale of the real property will be split proportionately between Parks and County based upon the percentage of funding contributions for the original purchase. \$1,867,300 (71%) is being transferred to the County of Riverside Executive Office Capital Improvements Program for future capital improvements and expansion of park and recreational facilities in District 1. The remaining \$762,700 (29%) will be retained by Parks for improvements to District 1 Regional Park sites, which include Santa Rosa Plateau Nature Center and Box Springs Reserve.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The contribution of sale proceeds from the District to the County Executive Office will allow for more efficient utilization of funds for capital improvements and expansion of park and recreation facilities within the First District.

Additional Fiscal Information

Upon approval of the contribution by the Board of Directors, and after subsequent approval of this budget adjustment by the Board of Supervisors, the District will transfer the \$1,867,300 contribution amount to the County Executive Office via journal entry.
