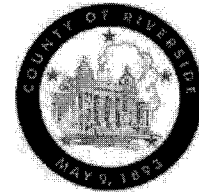





BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to Norco Educational Support Team (NEST) will sponsor the Norco Film and Art Festival which raises money to assist students with AP and College Entrance Exams and Applications, help with fees to join band, choral and floral design and help teachers of special needs children.
2. The donation to the Spanish town Heritage Foundation will be used to sponsor the annual Tamale Festival, which raises money for maintenance and education programs at the historic Trujillo Adobe.
3. The donation to the American Cancer Society will be used to sponsor the Corona Relay for Life which raises funds to support cancer research, education and services to residents in Riverside County.
4. The donation to the Corona Senior Center will be used to sponsor their Senior Travel Program which provides a sense of independence to the aging population. The program provides transportation to the various amenities Southern California has to offer, including whale watching, local museums, aquariums and festivals.
