SUBJECT: Authorize and Approve an Increase to the Contract Aggregate to Provide Recovery Residence Services (District: All) [\$850,000 annually, up to \$85,000 in Additional Compensation, \$4,250,000 total for 5 years]; 100% Federal

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


1. Authorize and Approve an increase to the annual contract aggregate amount of \$350,000 to \$850,000 for recovery residence services;
2. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, based upon the availability of funding and as approved by County Counsel to: a) increase or decrease the Agreements listed in Attachment A; b) shift funds while staying within the 10% contingency of the approved aggregate amount of \$850,000; c) sign renewals and amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the Agreements through June 30, 2023.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Riverside University Health System – Behavioral Health operates a continuum of care system that consists of County-operated and contracted service providers delivering a variety of Substance Abuse Treatment Services within each geographic region of Riverside County. As a component of this continuum of care, RUHS-BH utilizes several Recovery Residences to assist in providing a stable living environment to consumers receiving outpatient treatment in the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Program (SAPT). On August 28, 2018 (#3.57), the Board approved the \$350,000 contract aggregate for recovery residence services. RUHS-BH is seeking an increase to the contract aggregate to assist additional consumers in need of these services, as well as increase the allowable length of stay for those consumers.

Therefore, RUHS-BH is requesting that the Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the request to increase the contractor aggregate by \$500,000 annually for those contractors listed in Attachment A; and authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign renewals and amendments through June 30, 2023 as outlined herein.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

These services are a component of Behavioral Health’s system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of consumers and the community.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On December 5, 2017, RUHS-BH in conjunction with Riverside County Purchasing issued the Request for Proposal (RFP) #MHARC-212 for Recovery Residences via the Public Purchase website. The Public Purchase website notified 168 organizations of the RFP, and 66 organizations were notified of the RFP via E-Mail. In total, 68 organizations accessed and/or downloaded the bid documents. Organizations had the opportunity to submit proposals for each geographic region in Riverside County. Seven organizations submitted proposals with proposed daily rates for Recovery Residence services. One organization voluntarily withdrew their proposal, and a second organization proposed a best and final rate that was significantly higher than the competitive average day rate for this service. An evaluation committee recommended the remaining five bidders to be awarded a contract for Recovery Residences. The recommended funding amounts were determined based upon the geographical/regional need

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for recovery residences, the number of beds available to the County at each facility, and the proposed ancillary services offered to residents.
