

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

By Minute Order dated December 4, 2018 (Agenda Item 3.51), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the installation of traffic signalization and lighting at the "T" intersection of Gilman Springs Road and Bridge Street in the Gilman Hot Springs area of the County.

At this intersection, Gilman Springs Road is currently a two lane highway that travels in the northwest-southeast directions with two through lanes and a left-turn lane for northbound vehicles turning southwest onto Bridge Street. Bridge Street is a two-lane facility that travels in the southwest-northeast directions. The area in the immediate vicinity is currently undeveloped. The proposed traffic signal is expected to improve traffic operations along Gilman Springs Road at this intersection.

Project construction will include installing a traffic signal, safety lighting and necessary appurtenances, grading, constructing a retaining wall, installing concrete curb and gutter, and replacing existing traffic striping and signs.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account all issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The Addenda were issued to extend the bid receipt date and to modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and 2.

The contractor, PTM General Engineering Services, Incorporated is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2018/2019.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The contract is recommended to be awarded to PTM General Engineering Services, Incorporated for the total amount of \$422,224.

The project will be funded with West County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

The proposed budgets as shown on Attachment "A" includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

Six bids were received ranging from \$422,224 to \$638,980. All received bids were higher than the Engineer's Estimate. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by PTM General Engineering Services, Incorporated in the amount of \$422,224 which is \$69,037 (20%) above the Engineer's Estimate; however, it is \$97,090 (23%) below the average cost of the six submitted bids.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible contractor, PTM General Engineering Services, Incorporated.

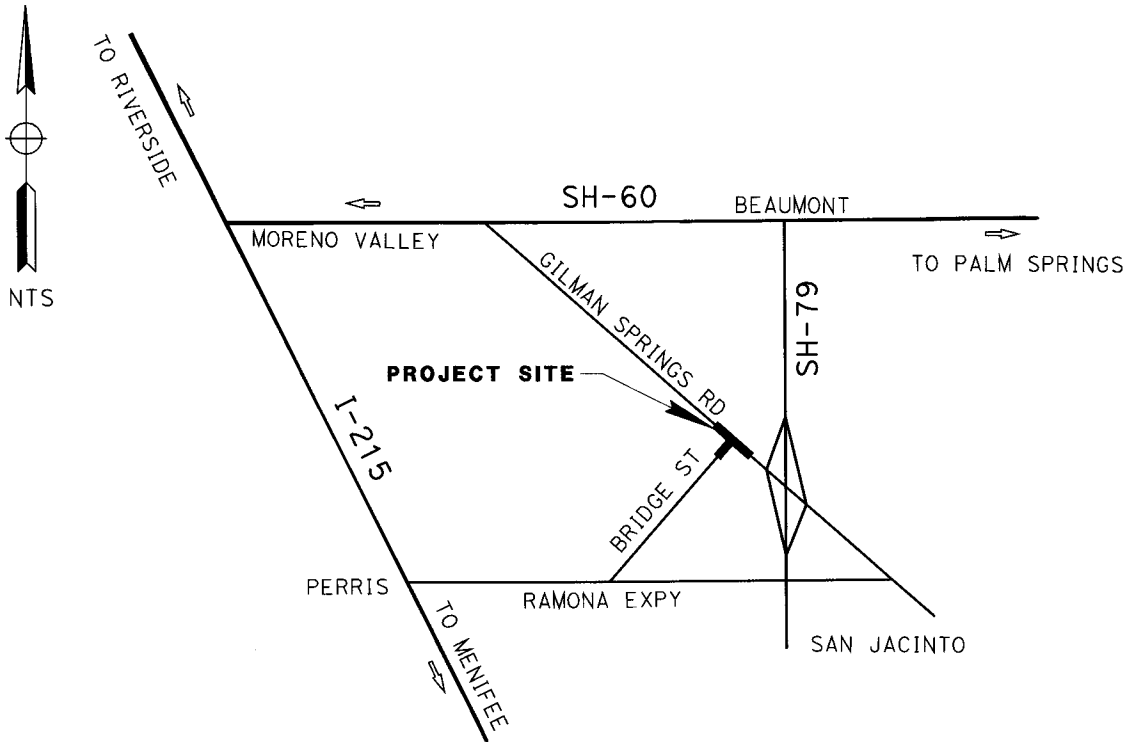
