

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **Studio 395 - \$5,000** funding will be used to support the programs and services provided to First District residents at the Lakeland Village Community Center.
2. **Villegas Park Advisory Committee - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the annual two-day Cinco de Mayo festival. The event is free and open to the public.
3. **Operation Prom Girl Southern California - \$1,500** funding will be used to support efforts to provide dresses to local high school girls that are going through hardships or circumstances which leave them unable to purchase a formal dress and accessories to attend their prom. 150-175 girls are expected to sign for assistance this year.
