

**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Temecula Valley American Assoc. of University Women (AAUW CASPF) \$2,000 – the funding will be used for seventh and eighth grade girls STEM camp scholarships at the University of San Diego.
2. Mount San Jacinto College Foundation \$1,000 – the funding will be utilized to fund student scholarships and other support services.
3. Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Inland Empire \$2,500 – the funding will be used for the Road to Success: Building Resiliency and Academic Achievement mentoring programs for young people.
