2. Direct the Emergency Management Department to prepare and process the amendment to Ordinance No. 533.



BACKGROUND:

Summary


Riverside County Ordinance No. 533 provides for the administration of the Emergency Management Organization for the County of Riverside. The County Executive Officer serves as the Director of Emergency Services and is responsible for providing direction and control of the Riverside County Emergency Management Organization. Amending Ordinance No. 533 is necessary due to an amendment of Government Code Section 8630 effective January 1, 2019. The amendment to the ordinance extends the period required for the governing body to review the need for continuing a local emergency from every 30 days to every 60 days.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of Ordinance No. 533 is to provide for the coordination of disaster mitigation, preparation, response and recovery activities for the protection of persons and property within the County of Riverside.

Additional Fiscal Information

The initiation and implementation costs are in the FY2018/2019 budget and no budget adjustment is required.
