

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

On January 8, 2019, the Mayor of Temecula approved the Second Amendment to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the County of Riverside Sheriff's Department. This Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of five (5) hours to the average level of daily patrol service hours and the equivalent of one (1) Deputy Sheriff position, and the elimination of two (2) Community Service Officer I positions. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated increase of \$369,700 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2019-20.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the Mayor of the City of Temecula approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.





SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND THE CITY OF TEMECULA

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, and the City of Temecula, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on April 5, 2016, for services effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2020, as amended on April 11, 2017, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:

One (1) Deputy Sheriff (unsupported) position - Gang Task Force






