BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Temescal Canyon Road widening projects are located south of the City of Corona within the unincorporated Temescal Valley area of western Riverside County. Temescal Canyon Road serves as the only north-south arterial that runs parallel to Interstate 15 in the Temescal Valley corridor and is used as an alternate route to avoid congestion on Interstate 15.

The scope of work consists of widening Temescal Canyon Road from two to four lanes in two segments: Dawson Canyon Segment 1 - Dawson Canyon Road to 0.7 mile northerly; and Dos Lagos Segment 2 - Dos Lagos Drive to Leroy Road (0.6 mile) (Projects).

The road widening requires that a number of existing Southern California Edison Company (SCE) power poles alongside the existing roadway be relocated to new positions to accommodate the widened roadway. Those SCE poles and facilities located within County right-of-way under franchise agreement will be relocated by SCE at no cost to the County. The facilities for which SCE has prior rights will also be relocated by SCE at cost to the County. In addition, where there is a need to install new street light poles within the Projects, SCE will install the facilities at cost to the County.

SCE has submitted invoices in the amount of \$117,000 to the County for the relocation and street light installation work. These invoices exceed the current delegation of authority of \$100,000 by the Director of Transportation. The Facilities Relocation Agreements will define the location of the relocated utility poles and street lights for both Projects and financial responsibilities for the utility relocations.

Construction of the Projects began in December 2018, and is anticipated to be completed by December 2019.

Environmental Impacts

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By Minute Order dated November 14, 2017 (Agenda Item 3.24), the Board of Supervisors adopted the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Initial Study with Mitigated Negative Declarations for the Project. The CEQA Notice of Determination was posted with the County Clerk's Office on November 14, 2017 and the 30-day posting terminated on December 20, 2017. The SCE power pole relocations and street light installations are included in the Project scope of work and nothing further is required for CEQA compliance.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Project will relieve congestion along Temescal Canyon Road, improve safety, and bring the road up to the current County design standards for Major Highways.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The billing is consistent with SCE's established billing rates for such work.


Additional Fiscal Information
