BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Political Reform Act prohibits a public official or employee from using his or her position to influence a government decision in which he or she has a financial interest. Government Code section 87300 requires local government agencies to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code identifying officials and employees required to file statements of economic interest based on the positions they hold. A local government agency, as defined by Government Code section 82041, includes the County of Riverside.

The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations section 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which may be incorporated by reference in a local government agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. The County of Riverside has incorporated 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730 and any amendments duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission in its conflict of interest code. This regulation and the Appendix to the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside, designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, constitutes the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside.

Each even-numbered year, Government Code section 87306.5 requires the County of Riverside to review its conflict of interest code and make appropriate revisions, if necessary. Such revisions include adding new positions, revising disclosure categories, revising the titles of existing positions, and deleting titles of positions that have been abolished and/or positions that no longer make or participate in making governmental decisions. Each department, agency, board, commission, committee, and council listed in the Appendix of the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside has reviewed its list of designated positions and disclosure categories. The following departments, agencies, boards, commissions, committees, and councils have found that revisions to its list of designated positions and disclosure categories are necessary:

Attached is the proposed amended Appendix to the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside with the above mentioned departments, agencies, boards, commissions, committees, and councils changes to its list of designated positions and disclosure categories.

The Political Reform Act requires the adoption of any amendments to a local government agency's conflict of interest code to be carried out under procedures that guarantee to officers, employees, members, and consultants of the agency and to residents of the jurisdiction adequate notice and a fair opportunity to present their views. Prior to the Board adopting the amended Appendix to the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside, the Fair Political Practice Commission recommends a 45-day comment period and a public hearing.

On January 29, 2019, Agenda Item 2.25, the Board of Supervisors set a public hearing on or after March 19, 2019 regarding the proposed amended Appendix to the Conflict of Interest Code

for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside. In addition the Board of Supervisors authorized and directed the Clerk of the Board to place an advertisement for the public hearing in the appropriate local publications and notify each affected designated official or employee.

After the close of the public hearing, it is recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution No. 2019-008, A Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside Adopting an Amended Appendix to the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside.

10 of Regulations, section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which may
11 be incorporated by reference in a local government agency's code, and which may be amended by the Fair
12 Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act; and

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, adopted the
14 provisions of 2 California Code of Regulations, section 18730, and any amendments to it as adopted by
15 the Fair Political Practices Commission, with an Appendix in which certain enumerated officials and
16 employees and members of certain enumerated boards, commissions, committees and the Grand Jury are
17 designated and disclosure categories are assigned, to constitute the Conflict of Interest Code for
18 Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside
19 ("Conflict of Interest Code"); and

20 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on March 14, 2017, adopted Resolution No. 2017-011
21 amending the Appendix of the Conflict of Interest Code; and

12 shall file their statements of economic interest with the head of their department or agency. Upon receipt
13 of the statements of economic interest, the head of the department or agency shall retain the statements on
14 file with their office, with the exception of the statement of the department or agency head who shall file
15 his or her own statement with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Consultants, members of boards,
16 commissions, committees and members of the Grand Jury shall file their statements directly with the
17 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Statements shall be filed by April 1 of each year to reflect interests
18 held in the prior calendar year.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Political Reform Act prohibits a public official or employee from using his or her position to influence a government decision in which he or she has a financial interest. Government Code section 87300 requires local government agencies to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code identifying officials and employees required to file statements of economic interest based on the positions they hold. A local government agency, as defined by Government Code section 82041, includes the County of Riverside.

The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations section 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which may be incorporated by reference in a local government agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. The County of Riverside has incorporated 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730 and any amendments duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission in its conflict of interest code. This regulation and the Appendix to the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside, designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, constitutes the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside.

Each even-numbered year, Government Code section 87306.5 requires the County of Riverside to review its conflict of interest code and make appropriate revisions, if necessary. Such revisions include adding new positions, revising disclosure categories, revising the titles of existing positions, and deleting titles of positions that have been abolished and/or positions that no longer make or participate in making governmental decisions. Each department, agency, board, commission, committee, and council listed in the Appendix of the Conflict of Interest Code for Departments, Agencies, Boards, Commissions, Committees, and Councils of the County of Riverside has reviewed its list of designated positions and disclosure categories. 


