**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Board of Supervisors approved the transfer of the 2010 Ford Expedition from the City of La Quinta to the Fire Department on January 29, 2015, as part of their Cooperative Agreement. Once the title was transferred the Fire Department and subsequently, the Emergency Management Department, was responsible for the maintenance and repair of the vehicle.

The vehicle is stationed in the City of La Quinta and is used primarily by the Emergency Services Coordinator assigned to the city. The city has hired an Emergency Services Coordinator (ESC) and will no longer contract with the County for Emergency Services. Therefore, the city has asked that the vehicle be transferred back to their possession for use by the ESC.


