Riverside County Workforce Development Board (WDB) is a private sector led policy and oversight body that supports economic expansion and the development of the regional workforce. The WDB is governed by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) which mandates that more than 50% of the WDB's members must come from the business community. In addition, WDBs are required to have representation from universities or community colleges, economic development, and workforce representatives including labor organizations. This ensures that federal funds for workforce development activities are expended on training and career coaching that meets the needs of the business community. Pursuant to WIOA, the Board of Supervisors, led by the Board Chairman who serves as the Chief Local Elected Official, is responsible for appointing WDB members for two year terms.

Mr. Ken Orr, Regional Coordinator, Southern California Laborer's Apprenticeship, has been part of his organization for over 10 years. He has also served as a member on the

Riverside County WDB for seven years. Mr. Ken Orr brings firsthand experience in the construction industry. He has worked on large scale construction projects and holds knowledge of the educational and training requirements for apprentices. He oversees apprenticeship programs that prepare apprentices to become the skilled journeymen. Mr. Orr maintains relationships with community based organizations to create awareness of apprenticeship programs, their importance and benefits. He brings experience and perspective to address the workforce development needs in the region.

Mr. Ken Orr, Coordinator at the Southern California Laborer's Apprenticeship, has expressed interest in continuing to serve on the Workforce Development Board as a Labor Representative for All Districts. If approved, he will serve a two-year term commencing February 15, 2019 and ending on February 15, 2021.
