

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **Mary S. Roberts Pet Adoption Center** - \$1,000 funding will be used to support their mission of eliminating the suffering of homeless cats and dogs by providing humane care for pets in transition. The center is a partner of the Riverside County Department of Animal Services.
2. **Arlington Business Partnership** - \$500 funding will be used to support the 17th Annual Chili Cook-Off & Car/Cycle Show on May 25, 2019 in Riverside's historic Arlington Village of the Arlington Business District. This event is free and open to the public.
3. **Vivian Stancil Olympian Foundation, Inc.** - \$500 funding will be used to support the efforts to provide swim and water safety instruction at no cost.
4. **Canyon Lake Woman's Club** - \$1000 funding will be used to support their Scholarship Program which will award scholarships to Canyon Lake female residents who are currently in their senior year of High School.
5. **Riverside County Sheriff's Department** - \$500 funding will be used to support their employee and community volunteer recognition ceremony.
