



BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the Riverside Community College District Foundation will be used to sponsor Norco College's "Dinner with the President" event which is an annual fundraising event for the college with all proceeds benefitting Norco College programs and students.
2. The donation to the Fire & Burn Foundation will be used to sponsor their "Embers of Hope" Youth Camp for burn injured children ages 5-17. The camp programming offers therapy, education and friendship in order to help the children heal from their physical scars.
3. The donation to Starting Over will be used to assist with three (3) of their programs including the Path to Staffing which provides employment readiness training; their annual Back Pack and School Supply Give Away which provides backpacks to over 600 students; and the Building a Beloved Corona Project which strives to increase civic engagement in the city and help connect people living below the poverty level with needed resources.
4. The donation to the Riverside Arts Academy will be used to support the Making Music in Education Conference which will teach music content for current and student teachers as well as provide current research linking music instruction to academic performance.
