

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Safe Alternatives for Everyone - \$2,000 the funding will be utilized for a fundraiser for Safe Alternatives for Everyone providing lifesaving domestic violence services to families in the Murrieta and Temecula Valley.
2. Riverside County Works - \$1,000 the funding will be used to support the Jamil Dada Character of Excellence Youth Awards recognizing high school students throughout all of Riverside County. Students are acknowledged for their academic and athletic achievements and exemplary character traits while overcoming some of life's most difficult and tragic situations.
3. Riverside County Sheriff's Department - \$500 the funding will be used for the annual awards ceremony that recognizes sworn and non-sworn staff members. In addition, the department also acknowledges community volunteers for the Sheriff's Department.
4. Riverside County Youth Commission - \$500 the funding will be utilized for the Riverside County Youth Summit which brings youth from all areas of the county the opportunity to work together with the Board of Supervisors to improve the present and future lives of youth in Riverside County.
