BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the Jurupa Area Recreation and Park District will be used to assist with the funding of many projects, including: the Jurupa Valley 5K, Veterans Memorial Wall Ceremony, Independence Day Celebration, Concerts in the Park and Spooktacular.
