BACKGROUND:

Summary

The City of Coachella desires to amend the agreement for Fire Protection, Fire Prevention, Fire Marshal, Rescue and Medical Emergency Services with the Riverside County Fire Department. The First Amendment is to add the Fire Engine Use Agreement to the Cooperative Agreement between the City of Coachella and the County of Riverside. There are no changes in the level of staffing since the signed Agreement. The term of this agreement is July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2021 and was approved by the Board of Supervisors on May 22, 2018, Item 3.18.

The Fire Engine Use Agreement ensures a working fire engine is available for the city at all times under this agreement. When the Fire Department Fleet personnel determine the fire engine is due for replacement, the Department will purchase a new fire engine; and, the old fire engine may be surveyed or reallocated as a second roll response fire engine.

The First Amendment has been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There are no changes to the staffing level in the First Agreement; therefore, there will be no impact on businesses or citizens of the City of Coachella due to the approval of the First Amendment to the Cooperative Agreement.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Fire estimates receiving revenue of \$25,800 in FY 19/20 and \$25,800 in FY 20/21 with the addition of the Fire Engine Use Agreement to the Cooperative Agreement.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The City of Coachella has been contracting for Riverside County Fire Services since 1990. Fire estimates receiving FY 19/20 \$25,800 and FY 20/21 \$25,800 of revenue with the addition of the Fire Engine Use Agreement to the Cooperative Agreement. The previous Cooperative Agreement was approved by the Board of Supervisors on May 22, 2018, Item #3.18.

A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION, FIRE PREVENTION RESCUE AND MEDICAL EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF COACHELLA

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT to Provide Fire Protection, Fire Prevention Rescue and Medical Emergency Services (this "Amendment") is made and entered into this 2000 day of April , 2019 (the "Effective Date"), by and between the County of Riverside, on behalf of the Fire Department, a political subdivision of the State of California, (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY") and the CITY of Coachella, a duly created city (hereinafter referred to as "CITY"). COUNTY and CITY are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties".

RECITALS

- A. The Parties entered into that certain Cooperative Agreement to Provide Fire Protection, Fire prevention rescue and Medical Emergency Services effective as of May 22, 2018, (the "Cooperative Agreement") as more particularly described in the Cooperative Agreement, a copy of which is in the possession of the COUNTY and each CITY.
- B. The PARTIES desire to amend the Cooperative Agreement in accordance with and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Amendment.
- NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the PARTIES agree as follows:
- <u>SECTION I: AMENDMENT</u>. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Cooperative Agreement, the Cooperative Agreement is amended as follows:
- (a) Section III (G) is added with the following: "SECTION III: PAYMENT FOR SERVICES (G) Additional terms as set forth in the attached Exhibit "C" are incorporated herein and shall additionally apply to this agreement regarding payment for the Fire Engine Use Agreement.
- (b) Except as specifically modified hereby, the Cooperative Agreement shall continue in full force and effect and is hereby ratified and confirmed as amended by this Amendment.
- (c) This Amendment shall be construed, interpreted, and enforced under the laws of the State of California.
- (d) All capitalized terms not defined in this Amendment shall have the same meaning ascribed to those terms in the Cooperative Agreement.
- (e) In the event of any conflict between the terms of this Amendment and the terms of the Cooperative Agreement, the terms of this Amendment shall govern and control.

 (f) This Amendment may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same Amendment. (g) The Recitals are by this reference incorporated herein and made a part of
