

Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing minor roadway widening improvements on Ellis Avenue at the intersection of Theda Street in the Community of Good Hope of the County.

Ellis Avenue is currently a two lane secondary road that travels in the east-west direction; Theda Street is also a two lane secondary road that travels in the north-south direction. A T-intersection is formed where both roads meet. The minor widening will provide a left turn pocket for traffic traveling westbound on Ellis Avenue and turn southbound unto Theda Street.

Proposed improvements include placement of asphalt concrete pavement, installation of corrugated steel pipe for relocation of an existing roadside drainage ditch, reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike and driveways, removal of trees, installation and relocation of roadside signs, placement of thermoplastic crosswalks and pavement markings, and any other work as may be required.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The Ellis Avenue and Theda Street Intersection Improvement Project proposes minor widening on the intersection of Ellis Avenue and Theda Street to install a left-turn pocket within the County right-of-way. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the installation of a left-turn pocket and associated safety improvements do not create additional automobiles lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The Ellis Avenue turn pocket widening project at Theda Street intersection improves traffic flow by providing a lane for the westbound traffic turning left to move out of the flow of traffic. Ellis Avenue and Theda Street are used as routes to the Good Hope Elementary School located on the southeast corner of the intersection. The Ellis Avenue turn pocket widening project work will be phased to keep Ellis Avenue and Theda Street open during construction.

The work is scheduled to begin in summer 2019 and will take approximately five weeks to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$334,470. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2019/20 and will be funded with, County Service Area 41 funds and with Gas Tax/HUTA funds.

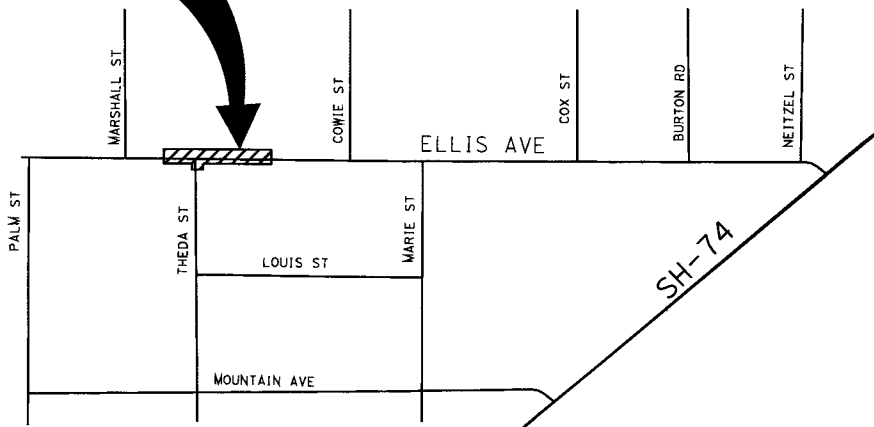

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes pavement widening at the intersection of Ellis Avenue and Theda Street to install a left turn-pocket on Ellis Avenue. Ellis Avenue is approximately 38 feet wide and is a two-lane facility that travels in the east and west directions. Theda Street is approximately 50 feet wide and is a two-lane facility that travels in the north and south directions. The proposed improvements will include the following:

- Pavement widening to install a left-turn pocket
- Grading existing road-side drainage ditch
- Construct new drainage pipe and cleanout riser
- Reconstruction of dike, driveway, and drainage pipe
- Utility relocation
- Tree removal
- Removal/installation of traffic striping, pavement markers, and signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right-of-way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside cell criteria areas. This project is not within cell criteria areas and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes minor widening at the intersection of Ellis Avenue and Theda Street to install a left-turn pocket on Ellis Avenue. The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the installation of a left-turn pocket and necessary safety improvements do not create additional automobile lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.
