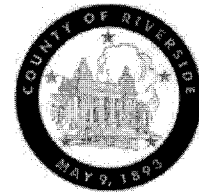

SUBJECT: RIVERSIDE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM - PUBLIC HEALTH: Ratify and Approve the Grant Agreement Between California Community Foundation and Riverside County Department of Public Health for the Youth Suicide Awareness and Resiliency Project for the Performance Period of December 1, 2018 through December 1, 2020; District 5. [\$80,000 – 100% California Community Foundation] (4/5 vote required)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Ratify and approve the Grant Agreement between California Community Foundation and Riverside County Department of Public Health for the Youth Suicide Awareness and Resiliency Project (Grant Agreement) in the amount of \$80,000 for the period of performance of December 1, 2018 through December 1, 2020;
2. Authorize the Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors to sign the Grant Agreement on behalf of County; and
3. Authorize the Director of Public Health, or designee, to take all steps necessary to implement the Grant Agreement including, but not limited to, signing subsequent amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the agreement, and signing all certifications, assurances, reports, or other related documents required by the California Community Foundation, subject to County Counsel approval.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments as specified on Schedule A, attached.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The County of Riverside Department of Public Health-Injury Prevention Services (IPS) received funding from California Community Foundation to implement educational workshops and a community support group to assist LGBTQ youth in the Perris area. The purpose of the grant is to address the unique mental health needs of LGBTQ youth and to provide education and training resources to increase their knowledge in mental health disparities, suicide prevention, and ultimately increase resiliency.

Staff recommend that the Board ratify and approve the attached Grant Agreement in the amount of \$80,000 for the period of performance of December 1, 2018 through December 1, 2020.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The services will benefit the LGBTQ youth within the community of Perris by offering expanded access to resources.



Grant Purpose: Cover a 24 month funding period beginning 12/1/2018 through 12/1/2020 to support Youth Suicide Awareness and Resiliency Project

Payment #2 in the amount of \$40,000.00 will be disbursed on or before 1/1/2020

Detail to Include in Report:

- Conduct a 2-part interactive, educational workshop for (25) parents, caregivers, service providers & school personnel on the Mental Health Needs of LGBTQ youth.
- Forty (40) LGTBO youth will participate in a weekly psychosocial support group (SOURCE) designed to educate youth on mental health disparities, inclusive of adverse childhood experiences, suicide prevention and coping/resiliency strategies
- Program facilitators will engage a minimum of ten (10) youth within the SOURCE support group as peer leaders in two (2) peer led health promotion activities to increase community awareness on the unique mental health needs of LGTBO youth population.
- Eighty (80) parents, community and/ or school leaders will participate in an interactive presentation on unique strategies to promote resilience and protective factors for LGTBO youth with a special emphasis on the sub-population of youth of color.

Additionally, as a condition of this grant, grantee partner shall promptly notify the Foundation in writing of any significant changes in the organization's structure, leadership, or financial circumstances that could affect the ability of the grantee to effectively implement the funded activities or general charitable mission of the organization.

- 2) Payment of Grant: Payment of this grant may be made by the Foundation from the **Kaiser Permanente Southern California Fund for Charitable Contributions**, a donor advised fund of the Foundation.
 - a. Therefore, this grant may not be used to provide any material benefit or privilege to the donor advisor/s or any individual related to the donor advisor/s (e.g., membership benefits, event tickets, goods bought at auction, religious benefit, etc.)
 - b. Not be used to support political campaigns or lobbying activities.
 - c. Payment of grants from donor advised funds is subject to the availability of unencumbered fund assets equal to the payment amount.
- 3) Governing Law: This agreement and grant shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of the state of California.
- 4) Entire Agreement: This agreement supersedes any prior or contemporaneous oral or written understanding or communications between Grantee, the Foundation and the donors and constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to its subject matter. This agreement may not be amended or modified, except by mutual agreement and in writing, signed by both parties.
