Born on December 27, 1921 in Riverside to Howard and Eva Waite, Barbara was raised with her sister Beverly and her brother Richard. She graduated from Poly High in 1939 and was active with the school newspaper. She was also the first Poly High Majorette. She graduated from UCLA with a degree in Teaching and was a member of the sorority Alpha Delta Pi, Alpha Chi Chapter.

In 1942, Barbara married Franklyn Gile, who was finishing flight training to captain a B-17 during World War II, serving in the United States Army Air Corps. They enjoyed flying and had various private planes.

Active in the community, Barbara and Franklyn were instrumental in getting the March Air Field Air Museum moved from East of the landing strip to the West side near Interstate 215. Her favorite hobby was restoring carousel animals with 20 having been displayed at the Riverside Art Museum and the LA County Fair. They played with Victoria Club's bridge group and were avid cruisers. She also enjoyed skiing at Tahoe and the French Alps.

Barbara was a loving and devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and friend. She is survived by her sons Dennis and Jeff; her grandchildren Alex and Adam; and her great-grandchildren Cassidy, Lucy, Tessa, Dylan, and Eamon.

Barbara's memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved her. She will be greatly missed but never forgotten.

As an instrumental force in the community, Council Member Hyatt worked tirelessly for the City of Calimesa for over 30 years. He helped the City incorporate and served on the City Council for most of the past 20 years. He began serving on the Calimesa City Council as soon as the City incorporated in December 1990 and remained on the Council continually since then except two terms, from 1998 to 2006. He also served as Mayor three different times during his terms in office and was most recently reelected to the City Council in November 2018.

Along with his service to Calimesa, Jim served as a member of the Western Riverside Council of Governments' Board of Directors, the Riverside County Transportation Commission's Board of Directors, as well as on the Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority and the Southern California Association of Governments.
