



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Menifee Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$5,000

The funding provides support for yearly Chamber activities that helps promote and foster business development in the 5th District.

2. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee - \$5,000

The funding helps put on the orchestra at the national cemetery for the Concert for Heroes that honors veterans, their families, and their sacrifice to this nation.

3. Riverside County Works c/o Jamil Dada - \$5,000

The funding provides support for the Jamil Dad Character of Excellence Youth Awards but most importantly it provides support for character development for our youth. It tackles on bullying, pervasive youth violence and other issues harming our youth.

4. Smiles for Seniors Foundation- \$2,000

The funding provides funding for senior citizens in the 5th District who have fallen in financial hardships. Smiles for Seniors helps with the financial cost of sustenance and cost of living expences.

5. Operation Prom Girl- \$2,000

The funding will provide an opportunity for low income students to attend a prom of their own. It provides more than a dress, it provides positivity message for recipients of funding.

6. Beaumont High School " Beaumont HS Athletic Booster Club"- \$500

The funding will help maintain the operational cost of the afterschool club along with the purchasing of athletic equipment for the students in the 5th District.

7. California Inland Empire Council-Mt Rubidoux- \$3,000

The funding will provide the continual support for the Boy Scout Five Nations activities throughout the year such as camping and educational seminars.

8. Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park Improvement Corporation- \$10,000

The funding will provide much needed developmental upgrades to Noble Creek Park for constituents in the 5th District.

9. Global Society for Female Entrepreneurs- \$2,000

The funding will provide various opportunities to promote female entrepreneurial development through education seminars.

10. Calimesa Chamber of Commerce- \$8,875

The funding will provide the continual support for 5th District chamber of commerce. It will provide a scholarship opportunity for high school graduating seniors.

11. Boys and Girls Club of Menifee and Perris Clubhouse- \$10,000

The funding will provide an opportunity for 5th District youth to participate in afterschool programs that enrich their learning experience.
