2. Appoint Greg Rodriguez (Patient Representative) to the FQHC Community Health Center Board for a term of May 1, 2019 until April 30, 2023.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

As a requirement of the Federal Qualified Health Center (FQHC) designation from the U. S. Department Health and Human Services, the County must have a “Co-Applicant” Board, with the majority of members being actual users of the services at the FQHCs. The Community Health Center Board (CHCB), which was established under County Ordinance 751.1, serves as the FQHC Co-Applicant. The CHCB has thirteen (13) to twenty-five (25) positions of which a majority must be users of services at the Community Health Centers. The members as a whole must also be broadly representative of the characteristics of the population served by the FQHCs.
