BACKGROUND:

Summary

The proposed ordinance adjusts and updates Treasurer-Tax Collector's various fees last adopted by the Board via Ordinance No. 654.20 for 26 existing types of services provided by the Treasurer-Tax Collector to the general public, taxing agencies and special districts. It also adds a new fee for recovering the significant staff time and costs the Treasurer-Tax Collector incurs in collecting delinquent tax bills in connection with bankruptcy cases. The new fee, Bankruptcy Payment Processing Fee, is intended to recover costs associated with researching and submitting bankruptcy claims and processing bankruptcy partial payments as well as providing information requested by the interested parties. These changes are a result of our calculations to determine the cost of providing the services based on our operating costs. For the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year, while 15 fees are adjusted upward, and 11 fees will decrease, it is estimated to have an overall negative financial impact, resulting in lower costs to the general public, taxing agencies and special districts. On April 19, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved the introduction of Ordinance No. 654 and directed the Clerk of the Board to set a public hearing for May 21, 2019 and to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting.

This amendment to Ordinance No. 654 is exempt from CEQA. The amendment merely updates fees charged by the office of the Treasurer-Tax Collector to recover costs of providing the services. This amendment is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to the CEQA as reflected in CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 (b)(3). Because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adjustment of the fee
