RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors direct the County Executive Officer (CEO), Chief Operating Officer (COO) and the Deputy CEO of Legislative Affairs to:

1. Enroll the County of Riverside in membership with the Association of Defense Communities (ADC) in Washington D.C.;
2. Assign the Deputy CEO of Legislative Affairs to be the primary point of contact with the Association of Defense Communities Executive Team;
3. That the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors designate two members of the Board to serve as primary and alternate representatives to the Association of Defense Communities in Washington D.C. and, when necessary, attend meetings as their schedules permit;
4. Advise the County's lobbyists in Washington D.C. and Sacramento of our membership in the Association of Defense Communities and ensure that the team make contact with the Legislative Director of the Association of Defense Communities and work with ADC when directed or when appropriate;
5. That the CEO, COO and Deputy CEO of Legislative Affairs may from time to time ask various county departments or agencies for information and assistance related to defense and military installations and said agencies shall be permitted and authorized to participate in Association of Defense Community activities as necessary.

**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

BACKGROUND: Riverside County is the home to March Air Reserve Base, which is located in the 5th Supervisorial District, and the Naval Surface Warfare Center, which is located in the 2nd Supervisorial District. The County of Riverside is also host to the National Guard, Navy, Army, Air Force, Marines and Coast Guard Reserve operations. Combined, these military bases, installations and units have a direct economic impact of approximately \$1.5 billion dollars to the county's economy. This figure does not include the indirect economic impacts of the military bases. The Department of Defense also reports that approximately 900 defense contractors operate in the County of Riverside and many of its incorporated cities. Membership in the Association of Defense Communities will align our county with the many cities and counties across the nation in support of America's military. The Association of Defense Communities (ADC) is the connection point for leaders from communities, states and the military industry on community-military issues and installation management. Recent reports that a unit at March Air Reserve Base may be closed means the County of Riverside must be engaged and at the table before cuts are proposed or made to our local military bases and installations. ADC counts approximately 300 member organizations with 2/3 of them being county, city and state members.

The annual cost of membership in the Association of Defense Communities is \$450.00 per year for Community & State Membership.
