**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) (existing facilities), and Section 15061 (b)(2) Categorical Exemption;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the La Sierra Avenue Guardrail Reconstruction Project, in the Communities of Lake Hills and Lake Mathews; and Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Road Guardrail Reconstruction Project, in the Community of Reche Canyon;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 26, 2019 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the La Sierra Avenue Guardrail Reconstruction Project, between El Sobrante Road and Orchard View Lane, in the Communities of Lake Hills and Lake Mathews; and Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Road Guardrail Reconstruction Project, between Hill Court and Woodson Road, in the Community of Reche Canyon.

The proposed improvements include removing existing segments of guardrail and replacing them with new guardrail at various locations. Additional work includes placement of guardrail reflective delineators, relocation of existing mail boxes, and other work that may be required. Approximately 7,200 feet of guardrail will be replaced along La Sierra Avenue between El Sobrante Road and Orchard View Lane; and Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Road between Hill Court and Woodson Road.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Guardrail Reconstruction.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

**Environmental Findings**

The La Sierra Avenue and Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Road Guardrail Reconstruction Project proposes safety improvements that are consistent with Section 15301(c) and Section 15061(b)(2). The proposed project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301(c) because the reconstruction of guardrail and associated safety improvements do not create additional traffic lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the

existing roadway and associated facilities. Section 15061 (b)(2) applies because the application of the categorical exemption is not barred by one of the exceptions set forth in Section 15300.2.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The proposed guardrail improvements will enhance roadway safety within the project limits by providing a safety barrier intended to shield motorists who leave the roadway.

The work is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2019. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one and a half months to complete.

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$782,400 and will be funded with Highway Safety Improvement Program funds for which the Department successfully competed.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to reconstruct approximately 7,200 feet of existing guardrail along La Sierra Avenue from El Sobrante Road to Orchard View Lane, and along Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Drive from Hill Court to Woodson Road Plan. La Sierra Avenue is a four lane facility with curb/gutter and dike at various segments along the roadway, and is classified as an arterial roadway under the County of Riverside General Plan. Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Drive are two lane facilities with dike along the roadways, and are classified as mountain arterial roadways under the County of Riverside General Plan. The project will include the following:

- Reconstruction of guardrail
- Placement of reflective markers
- Relocation and adjustment of mailboxes

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (WRMSHCP). Portions of the project are within cell criteria areas. In accordance with Section 7 of the WRMSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside cell criteria areas. This project is a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the WRMSHCP. The project will comply with the construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

**The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:**

**Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities** – The project proposes to reconstruct guardrail along La Sierra Avenue as well as Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Drive. The project proposes safety improvements that are consistent with Section 15301(c) because the project is a repair and maintenance that consists of reconstruction of guardrail of an existing road and associated facilities with negligible or no expansion of use.

**Section 15061 (b)(2) – Categorical Exemption** – The project is consistent with Section 15061(b)(2) because the project is exempt pursuant to Class 1 of Section 15301(c) under Categorical Exemptions and the application of the categorical exemption is not barred by one the exceptions set forth in Section 15300.2.

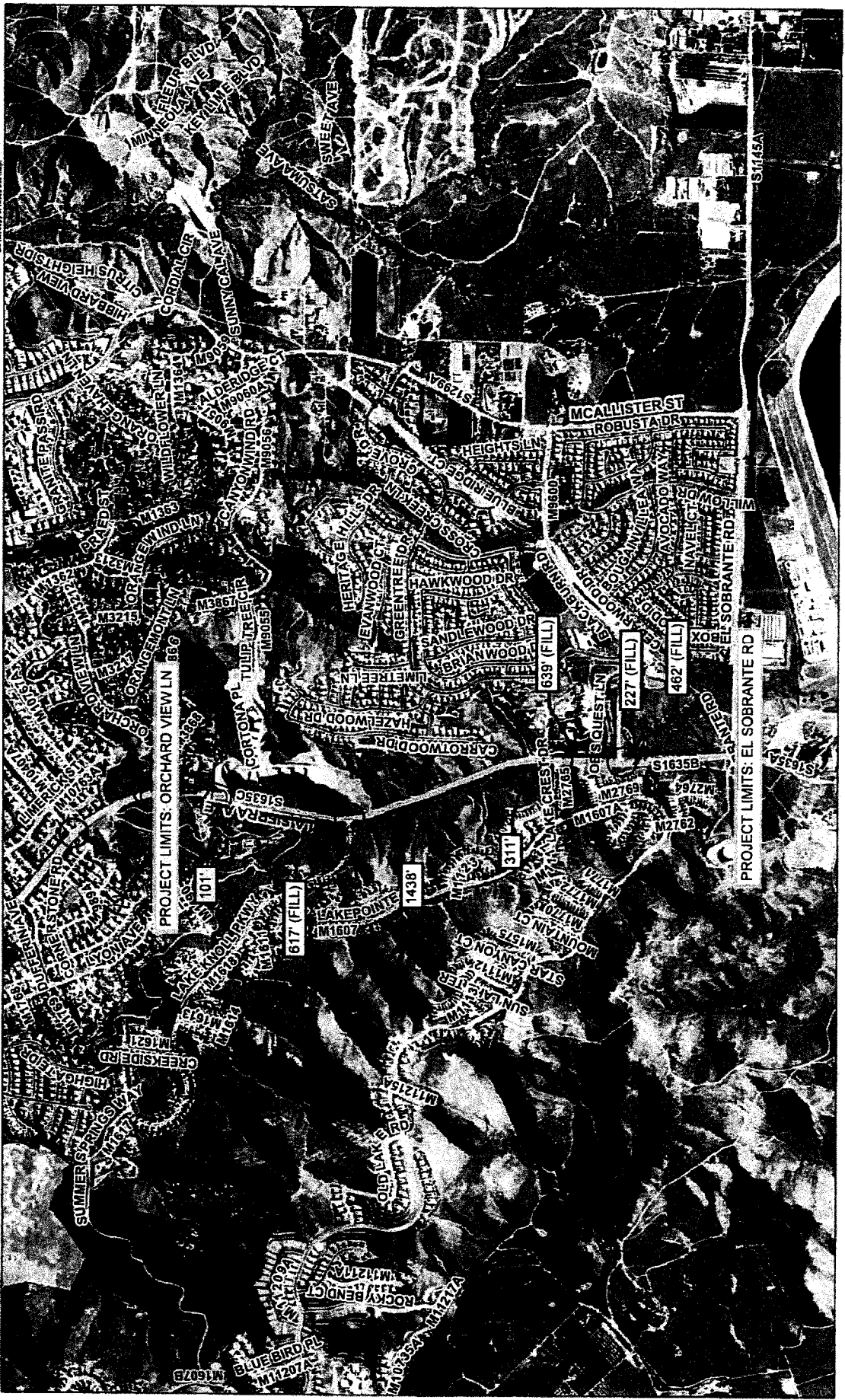

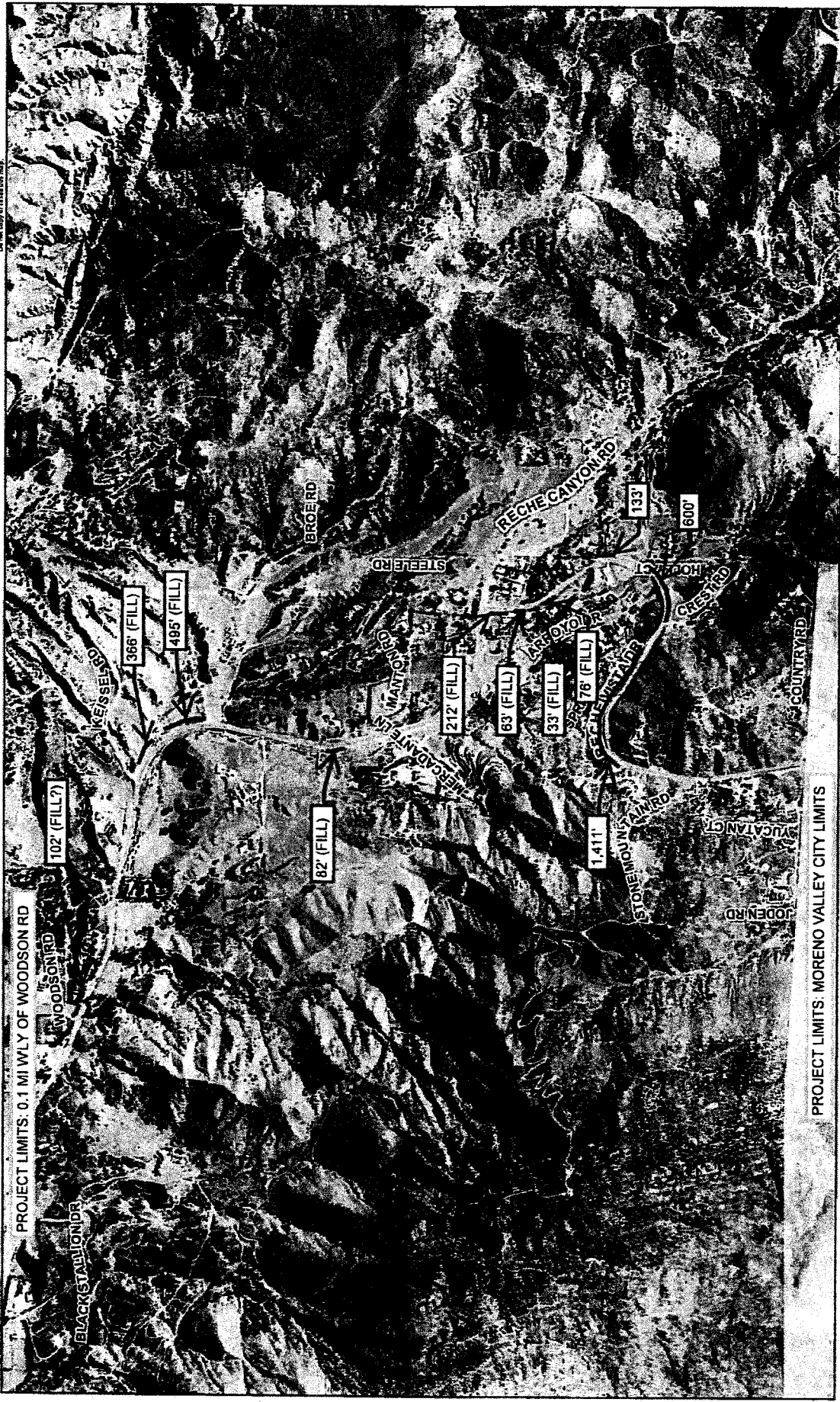
