

2. **County of Riverside Emergency Management Department - \$8,000** funding will help support the enhancement and expansion of volunteer Community Emergency Response Teams (CERT) and Disaster Response Teams (DRT) in the First District by assisting with the purchase of supplies, education materials, training opportunities and equipment.
